### School / Parent/ Child agreement

The success of your child's education hinges on the quality of the partnership between you and the school. We hope you will form the partnership.



#### **The School will:-**

1. Teach your child, catering for your child's individual educational needs and abilities within the group structure.
2. Undertake the teaching of literacy and numeracy as the main focus throughout your child's time at school. Assess the level of literacy and numeracy at entry to the school and to make continuous observations and assessment of your child's progress throughout school.
3. Ensure that your child is taught a broad and balanced curriculum, offering each area of the National Curriculum.
4. Observe and keep formative records of your child in order to plan appropriately for their next stage of development.
5. Have termly parent consultations/target settings to discuss your child's individual needs and progress.
6. Write and share a yearly report written about the progress and stage of development of your child.
7. Inform the parents/carer of any problem with regard to behaviour or learning in accordance with the Behaviour Code of Conduct.
8. Keep your child safe at all times
9. Encourage your child to be polite, kind and behave considerately.
10. Liaise with secondary schools to ensure a smooth transition for each child.



## **Parents/carers will do their best to:-**

1. Support your child with learning being done at home and at school by praising success and sympathising with difficulty.
2. Meet with the class teacher to discuss the best way to develop your child's learning.
3. Participate fully in the School's Home Learning programme.
4. Take part in any strategy meeting that may be called if your child is experiencing learning or socialising problems.
5. Support the school by following the school codes and behaviour policy
6. Assume responsibilities for your child during school time if contacted for any reason.
7. Ensure your child arrives punctually and attends school regularly.
8. Encourage your child to go to bed at a reasonable time during the school week.
9. Immediately inform the school of any worries you may have about your child's learning so that we can work together to improve the quality of your child's experience.



**The pupils will do their best and agree to the following:-**

1. I will follow the Golden Rules at all times.
2. I will work hard and do my best at all times.
3. I will behave sensibly and follow the school codes.
4. I will be kind and gentle to other children and adults and care for all living things.
5. I will help keep my classroom and school tidy.
6. I will complete my home learning every week.
7. I will be polite and respect all adults and pupils.
8. I will go to bed at sensible times during the school week.
9. I will be responsible for my belongings
10. I will tell my teacher or parent if anything is worrying them.
