2010 Admission arrangements for Glenthorne High School

I am writing to advise you that the Schools Adjudicator has partially upheld an objection to the admission arrangements for Glenthorne High School. As a result of his determination, the Schools Adjudicator has imposed changes to the admission arrangements for the school which means that it can not admit any children according to aptitude in the Performing Arts for September 2010 admission. All other aspects of the school's arrangements remain unchanged. This decision applies for one year only and means that no parent need complete a supplementary form for Glenthorne High School for 2010 admission.
