Nursery Christmas Activities

May I also take this opportunity to inform you that on Tuesday 15th December we will have a children's Entertainer for the Foundation Stage in the afternoon. As the Morning Nursery Class will not be in school during the afternoon, we would like to invite them all to come in to nursery at 1.30pm and be collected from nursery at 3pm.

On Friday 18th December we would like to invite all the nursery children (morning and afternoon nursery) to the morning session 9-11.30am, as we will be having our Christmas Party. The children will be able to wear their own party clothes. We will also be very grateful if you could contribute a food or drink item for our party. We will put up a list of food and drink items required nearer the time. There will be no nursery session in the afternoon on this day.

The Nursery will reopen for the Spring term on Tuesday 5th January 2009, unlike the rest of the school who return on Monday 4th January 2009. This is due to the induction of a small group of children joining us in January.
