Year 1 Trip to Brooklands Transport Museum

Red and Ruby classes are organising a visit to Brooklands Transport Museum in Weybridge on Tuesday 14th September 2010. A coach will leave the school at 9.00am and return to school at 3.05pm, depending on traffic. The visit will enable the pupils to learn more about this terms topic of transport. The trip will include a tour inside a Concorde and a ride on a penny farthing bicycle.

It is necessary to ask for a voluntary contribution of £14.60 per pupil towards transport and trip costs. Although there is no obligation to contribute and no pupil will be omitted from the visit on the grounds of cost, it will be necessary to have substantial voluntary contributions in order that the trip takes place. If there aren't sufficient funds then the trip could be cancelled. You can now pay for this trip online using Parentpay, or by cash or cheque.

Please complete the slip overleaf and return to the school office by Monday 13th September 2010.

If you are in receipt of income support, child tax credit provided you are not entitled to working tax credit, or an income based job seekers allowance and are unable to make a full voluntary contribution, please contact the school office.

The children will need to be in full school uniform with their jumper/cardigan over the top to make your child easily recognisable. Sensible shoes should also be worn. This trip is held both in and out of doors, so appropriate clothing and coats or a sun hat (depending on the weather) should be worn. They will also need to have a packed lunch in a named plastic bag with a non fizzy drink.
