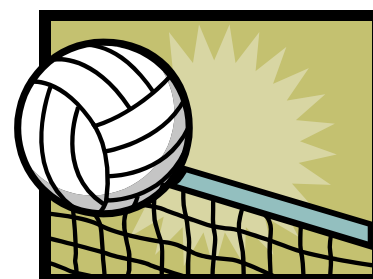
Talented Musicians

We are hoping to have a sports afternoon with lots of activities on Friday 16th July followed by a playground Party organised by FODs starting at 3.30.

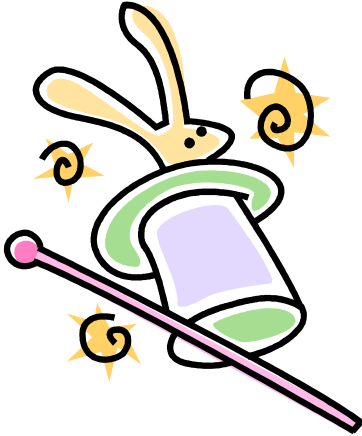
We will start the children's sports fun at 1.15 for an hour or so. You are very welcome to come and watch the event from 1.15. in the field behind the school.
