Enquiry Question of the week

Each week we will post an Enquiry Question from the week's learning alongside the answer we would expect. Ask your child the question and see how close your child is to answering the question fully. If they are finding it tricky, break down the answer together and see if they can work on learning more at home.

What has been the best part of your first week in Year 3?

A summary of next week:

SPAG: Nouns (e.g car, London, table) and adjectives (e.g. huge, red, loud).

Reading: Retrieving from a text.

Writing: Read 'How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth' and identify the different word classes.

Maths: Use a number line to 1000.

Science: What makes a rock a rock?

History: *When was the Stone Age and Iron Age and where do they fit on a timeline?*

RE: *What do Sikhs believe about God?*

PSHE: Knowing that families love each other, but can also fall out.
