Things to know for next week:

- ★ PE days are Mondays (indoor) and Fridays (outdoor). Forest school is Wednesday. Please check the forecast for the day and make sure your child is prepared for the weather.
- ★ Come and Meet the Year 2 team on Tuesday 10th September after school (around 3.30pm) in Buttercup Class. We will be giving a run through of the year and there will be time to ask us any questions you may have about Year 2.
- ★ The children should all now have a new bookmark and a new/relabelled Reading Record. By the end of next week all children who have recorded their reading daily and has had their record in school on the day it is checked will have 2 stickers.

Enquiry Question of the week

*Each week we will post an enquiry question from the week's learning, alongside the answer we would have taught them. Please take some time to ask your child the question and see how close your child is to answering the question fully. If they are finding it tricky, break down the answer together and see if they can continue to work on their learning at home.

Q: Where do I need to put a capital letter?

A: I need to put a capital letter to start my sentence, or for proper nouns. Proper nouns have capital letters because they are the names of specific people or places, like Susan or Spain. Common nouns are the names we give to every thing, like table or tree - they don't need a capital letter.

A summary of next week:

Phonics: Phase 5 sounds.

Reading: Retrieval skills

Writing: Understanding what makes a good sentence by using nouns, verbs, adjectives and conjunctions.

Maths: Numbers to 100: Building tens and ones numbers, representing them on a place value grid, and comparing numbers.

Science: How do we act like scientists?

Geography: Can you describe where the countries in the UK are using the direction North, South, East and West?

Computing: Reading and replying to an email.

RE: Who is Jesus and why is it important for Christians to follow him?

PSHE: To understand the role of a family.

Art: Make birthday cards for each other.

- Practise addition and subtraction skills on Numbots at least 3 times a week.

"Dip" into these tasks:

* Please note: you do not have to complete all 3 each week, but of course you can if you want to! Tasks will be set every Friday and can be handed in throughout the week, but are due by the following Friday so we have time to share with the whole class if they would like to. Not all tasks set will need to be recorded, but will simply be a way to connect with your child at home about their learning.

Home Learning Books have been given to each child, so they can record their work there if they choose to. It can also be emailed directly to your child's teacher if they prefer to work on a computer.

The children love sharing their work with each other, so please try to make time to complete at least one activity if you can.
