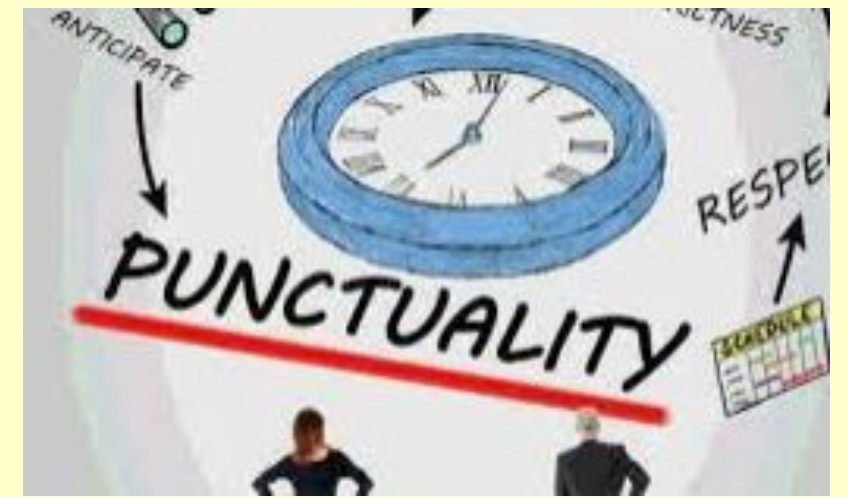
Just to show you how much we try to fit into any given day! So please be on time.

Punctuality

School gates open at 8.30

Early morning learning from 8.30

Behaviour



We focus on restorative conversations which make the children accountable for their actions, whilst focusing on the positive behaviours that are happening within school.

This does not mean that there are no consequences for poor behaviour choices, but we believe that behaviour needs to be taught and modelled, as with any of our learning.

Uniform



We want our children to be ambassadors for DPS and be proud of their appearance.

- No jewellery (including necklaces, bracelets, friendship bracelets, earrings)
- Children may wear an inexpensive watch to school (Smart watches are discouraged as they can be a distraction)

- We do try to take the children outside as much as possible, but cannot if they don't have the right clothing.

Pupil Premium / School Lunches



School meals are free this year, which is amazing!

Having a filling lunch can really impact the children for the day, and we are so happy to be able to provide that.

We still need families to apply for “Free School Meals / Pupil Premium / Universal Credit” if that applies to you. With every successful application, the school will receive funding to support your child, as well as future free school meals, money for trips, and holiday food vouchers (£15 a week).

All home learning, reminders for the week, information about school trips etc. will be on there, so it's important that you're signed up.

Home Learning

Home learning

- We know from our assessments that Reading and Writing are subject areas in which the children need as much support as possible.
- We have daily reading and phonics with the children, but we need your help and support to make sure that the children end the year on track with where they should be.
- We have invested in the Little Wandle and Big Cat books to support and structure their reading journey.
- The Reading Records and bookmarks have really helped the children take ownership of their reading (who doesn't want stickers and prizes?!) We need your help to encourage this further.

We have changed the way the prizes work this year, hopefully this will keep the children more interested throughout the whole year. They don't need to submit Reading Wows to earn extra stickers, just keep up with their daily reading.

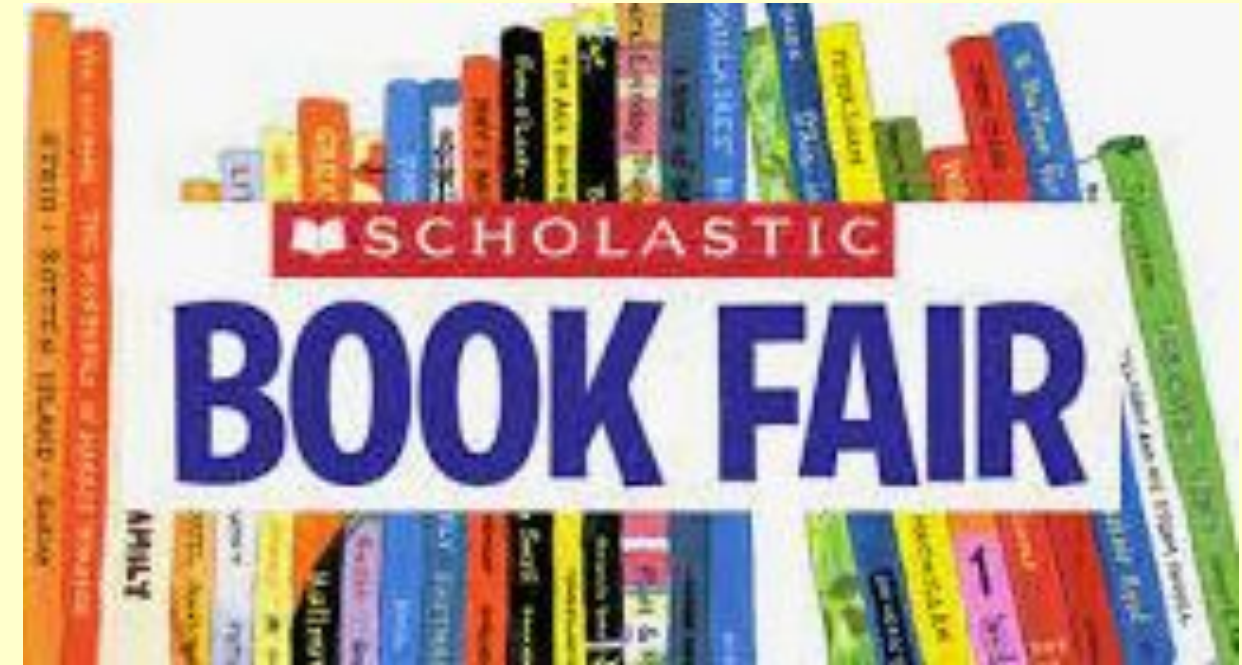
