Can you describe the location of Brazil within S. America and its physical features?

Top of South America, near the Equator in the Southern Hemisphere. 5500 miles from UK. (8850 km) 5th largest country by landmass and 7th most populated. Tropic of Capricorn passes through too. 6 different environmental zones

A summary of next week:
