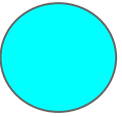

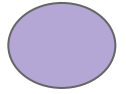

Restorative conversations will take place when the child is ready to have this.

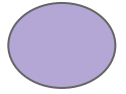
Calls home will be made for amazing or not so amazing behaviour.

New research shows the different numbers of words kids will have heard by age 5 based on how often parents read to them:

Never read to: 4,662 words

1-2 times per week: 63,570 words

3-5 times per week: 169,520 words

Daily: 296,660 words

Five books a day: 1,483,300 words

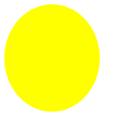

TOP THREE THINGS YOU CAN DO TO HELP YOUR CHILD

Download the TTRS app. Encourage your child to go on every day for 10 minutes.

Listen to your child read/read to your child as much as possible and ask them questions to check their understanding.

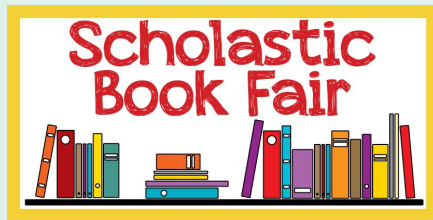

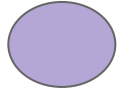

The Book Fair will also be in the hall.

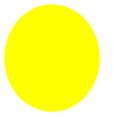




COST OF LIVING

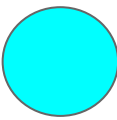
Never hesitate to speak up if the cost of an activity at school is too much at this time.

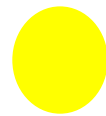

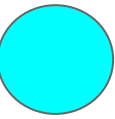
PUPIL PREMIUM

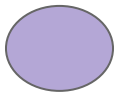


MOVING ON TO HIGH SCHOOL
