Enquiry Question of the week

Who were the Celts and what was the significance of the Iceni Tribe?

From the 16th century, 'Celts' was used as shorthand for the pre-Roman peoples of western Europe. It is believed that the Celts were a collection of tribes which originated in central Europe. Although separate tribes, they had similar culture, traditions, religious beliefs and language in common. Historians believe that one of the reasons for their arrival in Britain could have been trade. The ancient Celts were famous for their colourful wool textiles, forerunners of the famous Scottish tartan. The Iceni were a tribe of British Celts living in the area of modern Norfolk and north-west Suffolk. In 47 AD the Iceni rose in revolt after the Romans tried to enforce a law forbidding the carrying of weapons.
