Enquiry Question of the week

Please take some time to ask your child the question and see how close your child is to answering the question fully. If they are finding it tricky, break down the answer together and see if they can continue to work on their learning at home.

What are the continents and oceans of the world and how are they different from each other?

A: There are seven continents (Europe, Africa, Asia, Australia [sometimes called Oceania], North America, South America, Antarctica) and five oceans (Pacific, Atlantic, Southern, Indian and Arctic). We live in the UK, which is in Europe. The largest continent is Asia, and the smallest is Australia.

A summary of next week:

Phonics: review phase 5 sounds.

Reading: Retrieval skills

Writing: Using the story of The Jolly Postman to understand how to write letters.

Maths: Use a number line to estimate and compare numbers up to 100.

Geography: What are the common map symbols and why are they used?

Computing: Understand what an email attachment is, if they are safe to open, and how to organise information.

Science: How are different materials suitable for different purposes?

RE: What can we learn from the stories of Jesus?

PSHE: Families are all different.
