## Things to know:

## Enquiry Question of the week

Each week we will post an Enquiry Question from the week's learning alongside the answer we would expect. Ask your child the question and see how close your child is to answering the question fully. If they are finding it tricky, break down the answer together and see if they can work on learning more at home.

**How are different types of rock formed?**

Rocks can be formed three ways: Igneous (formed through volcanoes), Sedimentary (formed by layers of rock and animal remains) and Metamorphic (formed through continued heat and pressure).

## A summary of next week:

**SPAG:** Expanded noun phrases, e.g. the tall, hairy mammoth

**Reading:** Retrieving from a text.

**Writing:** Building paragraphs using full sentences of related ideas

**Maths:** Add and subtract using place value knowledge (place value chart, mental strategies)

**Science:** How are fossils formed?

**History:** How did the way they live change through the Bronze Age and Iron Age?

**RE:** Why is Guru Gobind Singh important? What does it mean to belong to the Khalsa?

**PSHE:** To understand the difference between friendship conflict and bullying.
