Enquiry Question of the week

Please take some time to ask your child the question and see how close your child is to answering the question fully. If they are finding it tricky, break down the answer together and see if they can continue to work on their learning at home.

What landmarks, human and physical features can you identify from aerial photos of London?

A: London is made up of different areas. There are some large parks like Hyde Park. There is a river called The Thames, which runs through London. There are many famous landmarks like The Gherkin, The London eye, Buckingham Palace and The Shard. There are many high rise buildings. There are lots of train lines above and below the ground. We can see these features in aerial photos by looking for colours and shapes (green grass and trees or grey/ silver rectangular buildings).

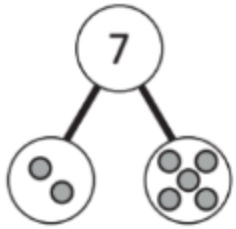

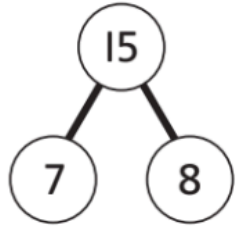
