How does Brazil compare with the UK?

Answer: Brazil is considerably larger in land size and population. Wealth and poverty exist alongside each other in both countries. Brazil has a wider range of biomes than the UK and is warmer due to its proximity to the Equator. The UK is a more developed country so opportunities are greater.
