Who is Benjamin Zephaniah? What did he do?

Benjamin Zephaniah is a well-known British poet, writer, and musician, celebrated for his lively performance poetry and works that often explore themes of social justice, racial equality, and multiculturalism. Born in Birmingham in 1958, he grew up in the Handsworth area, which greatly influenced his work. Zephaniah's poetry is known for its rhythmic style, reflecting his Jamaican heritage and engaging audiences with its powerful messages. He has written books and poetry that are widely used in schools, and he is also known for his work in television and radio. In addition to his literary contributions, Zephaniah is an activist and has been involved in various causes advocating for animal rights, veganism, and against injustice.
