Enquiry Question of the week

Each week we will post an Enquiry Question from the week's learning alongside the answer we would expect. Ask your child the question and see how close your child is to answering the question fully. If they are finding it tricky, break down the answer together and see if they can work on learning more at home.

What was life like in the Stone Age?

People lived a more simple/primitive life. They would live in caves or small huts and would hunt and forage to find food. Their clothes would be simple and mainly using furs to keep warm.
