Around the World tour on Monday 11th November 3.30pm-4.30pm. Please see the information which was sent out via school comms.

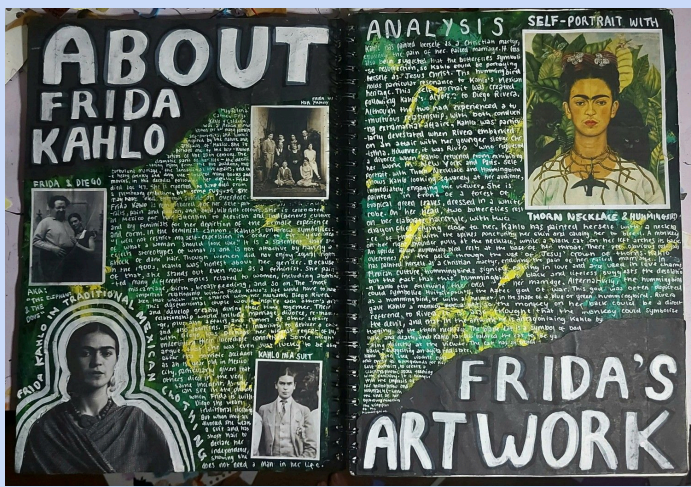
Forest School for Blue class on Tuesday 12th November. Please make sure your child is dressed for the weather.
