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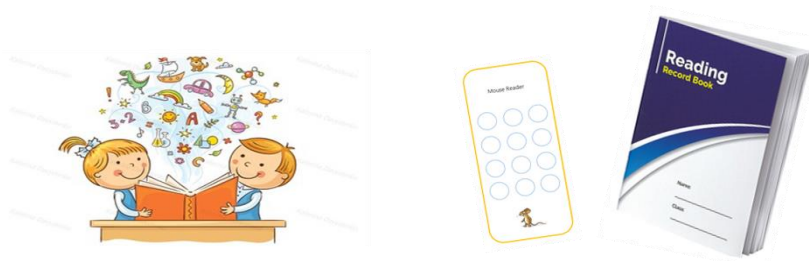


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# Reading Records

<b>Phonemes we focused on this week in school -</b>	<b>Phoneme Phonics - v</b> Put your teeth against your bottom lip and make a buzzing sound <b>vovv</b> . 	<b>Phoneme Phonics - w</b> Pucker your lips and bring them small as you say <b>w</b> . 	
<b>Phoneme Phonics - x</b> Mouth open, then push the air through as you close your mouth <b>xxxx</b> . 	<b>Phoneme Phonics - y</b> Down to the bottom of the vowel and back up to the top. 	<b>Phoneme Phonics - w</b> Down and up and down and up the vowel. 	
<b>Phoneme Phonics - y</b> Press the top lip against the top teeth. From the top again, across the top to the bottom. 	<b>Phoneme Phonics - g</b> Down, around the top and cut round the string. 	<b>Phoneme Phonics - g</b> Circle, tongue to the tip of your mouth, say g without opening your mouth <b>ggg</b> .
