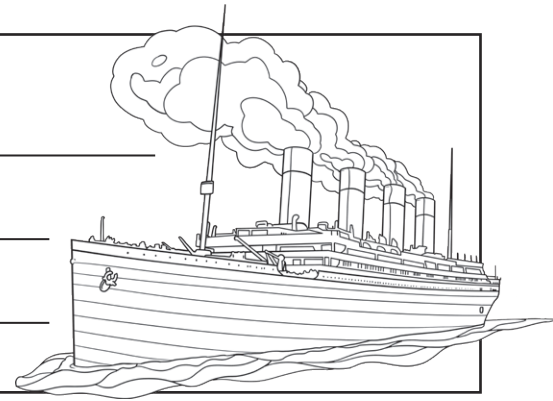

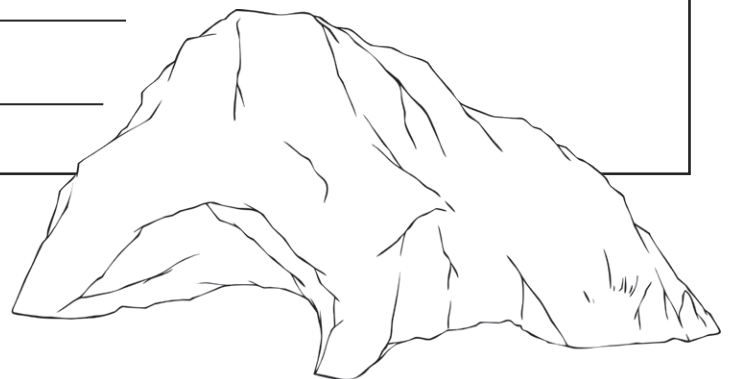

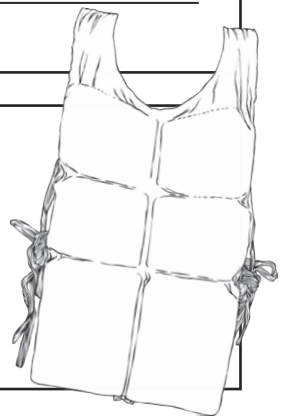

## Answers

Where was the Titanic built?

**The Titanic was built in Belfast.**

When did the passengers board the Titanic?

**The passengers boarded the Titanic on April 10<sup>th</sup> 1912.**

How many people were onboard the Titanic?

**There were 2,223 people on board the Titanic.**

What date and time did the lookout see the iceberg dead ahead?

**The lookout first saw the iceberg dead ahead on 14<sup>th</sup> April 1912 at 11:40 p.m.**

How long was there between the lookout seeing the iceberg dead ahead and the captain being told that the ship could only stay afloat for a couple of hours?

**It was 20 minutes between the lookout seeing the iceberg dead ahead and the captain being told that the ship could only stay afloat for a couple of hours.**

What happened between 12:05 a.m. and 12:25 a.m.?

**The lifeboats were uncovered and lowered. Women and children were the first to begin boarding the lifeboats. The Carpathia picked up the Titanic's call for help and set sail to help the Titanic.**

What was the name of the ship that came to help the Titanic?

**The name of the ship that came to help was the Carpathia.**

Why do you think there were 1,500 people left on the ship at 2:05 a.m.?

**There were not enough lifeboats for everyone to fit into.**

How many people did the Carpathia manage to save?

**The Carpathia managed to save 705 people.**
