Enquiry Question of the week

What happens when a volcano erupts?

Most volcanoes form at the boundaries of Earth's tectonic plates. These plates are huge slabs of Earth's crust and upper mantle, which fit together like pieces of a puzzle. These plates are not fixed, but are constantly moving at a very slow rate. They move only a few centimetres per year. When there is a gap in between the tectonic plates, magma fills the gap from the Earth's mantle, and a volcano is born. Volcanoes spew hot, dangerous gases, ash, lava, and rock that are powerfully destructive.
