Enquiry Question of the week

Each week we will post an Enquiry Question from the week's learning alongside the answer we would expect. Ask your child the question and see how close your child is to answering the question fully. If they are finding it tricky, break down the answer together and see if they can work on learning more at home.

What is the symbolism of the 5Ks which are worn by some Sikhs?

The 5Ks are special things that some Sikhs wear to remind them to be good, brave, and connected to their Sikh faith and community.

A summary of next week:
