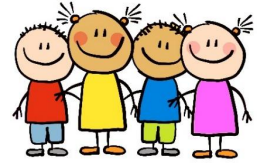

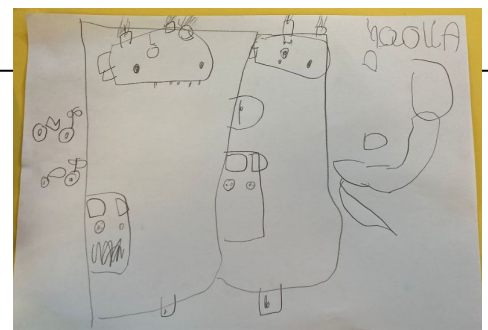


Where is Our School?

The children drew their own maps of their classes and included lots of fantastic details.

To find out more about Dorchester, the children went on a tour of the school to Mrs Bell's office! On the way, we saw where lunch is prepared and met some of the lovely ladies who work in our school office. We later looked at the different jobs people have in school. We found out that Kurtis is our caretaker who has a busy job looking after the school building, Yippy is our lollipop lady who keeps us safe crossing the roads and Rosaria is our cleaner who keeps our classrooms tidy and clean. We decided that all school jobs are very special and important.

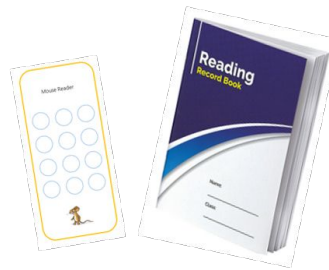

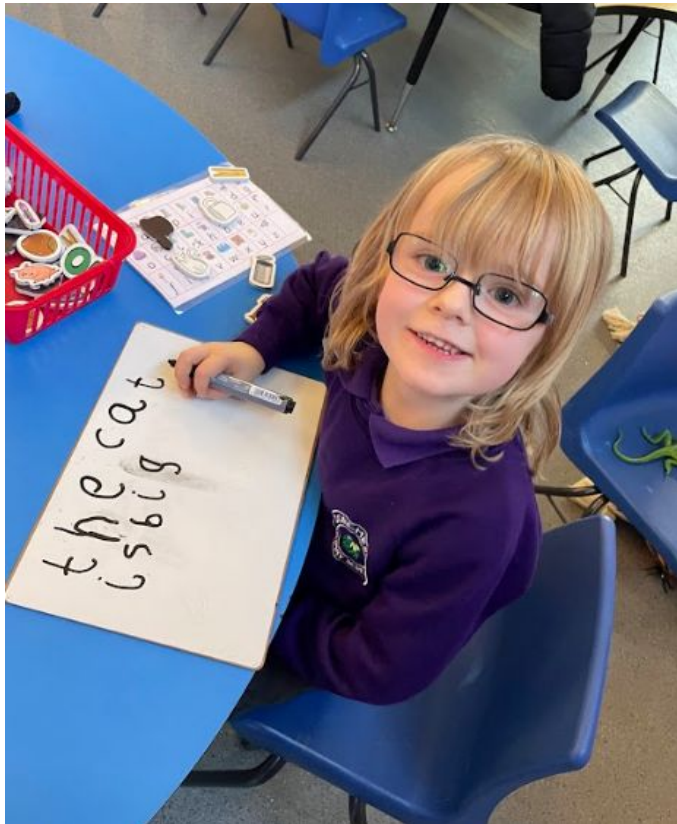
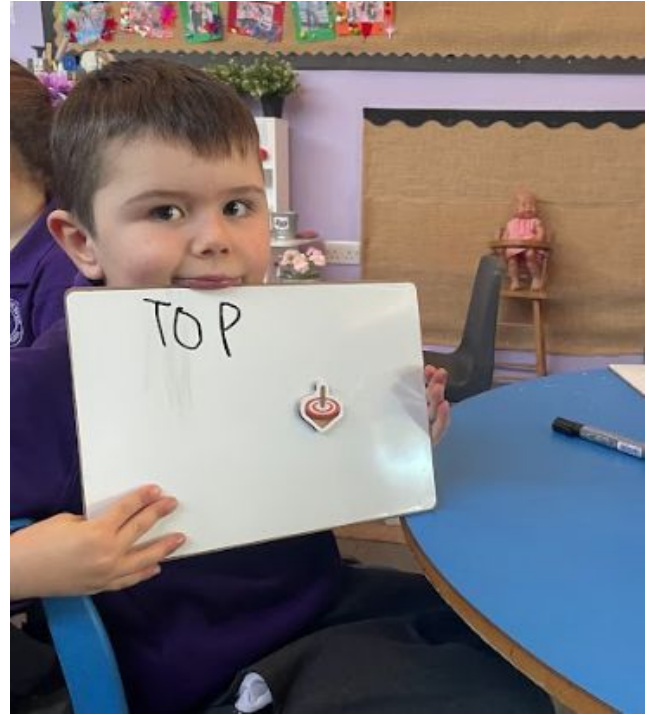
