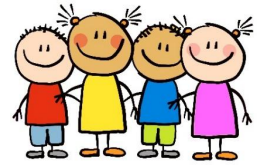


Peek at the Week

Dip and Do - Tricky Words

We are sending home the Tricky Words that have been taught this term. We are also sending a treasury tag. If you want to cut them up, you could punch a hole and make a card pack, that the children can use to learn them with you.

Last year we found that sending these words home, greatly increased the number of children who knew their tricky words by the end of the year, as well as increasing the automaticity or their reading.. We will send the next phase of words home near Easter. You do not have to cut them up but it makes it more fun for the children and they could even 'teach' you the words :)
