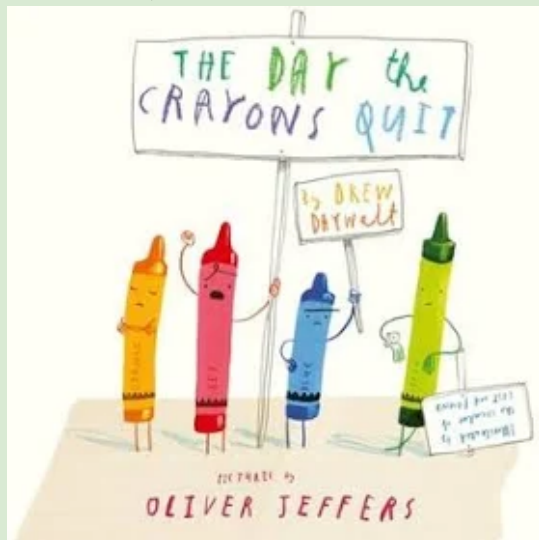
Next term our topic is Notable Tudors. As part of this topic the children will learn about important Tudors who were not Monarchs like John Blanke and William Shakesphere.
