Enquiry Question of the week

1. Where is Australia located in the world?

Australia is the smallest continent but is also one of the largest countries on Earth, 32 times larger than the UK. It lies between the Pacific and Indian oceans in the Southern Hemisphere. It is located near to Indonesia, Papua New Guinea, New Zealand, Tonga, Fiji, Samoa. Australia's capital is Canberra. The country is located on the other side of the world from the UK, meaning that time zones and climates are very different.
