Enquiry Question of the week

Each week we will post an Enquiry Question from the week's learning alongside the answer we would expect. Ask your child the question and see how close your child is to answering the question fully. If they are finding it tricky, break down the answer together and see if they can work on learning more at home.

Who were the ancient Egyptians and what roles did they have in society?

The ancient Egyptians were people who lived a very long time ago in a place called Egypt. They had different jobs in their society, like being a king (called a pharaoh), writing things down (scribes), building things (artisans), farming, and lots more. They believed in gods and built big, pointy buildings called pyramids. They also made beautiful art and jewellery. People in ancient Egypt had different jobs, and they all worked together to make their society work well.

Gold

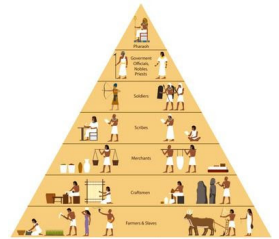
Create your own pyramid of jobs that existed in Ancient Egypt
