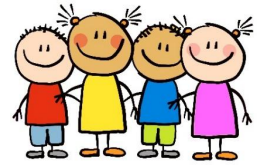


Peek at the Week

This week we been discussing things we are good at and have started writing simple sentences starting with 'I can...'

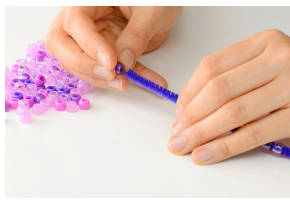
In Maths, we have been learning how to represent 6,7, and 8 on a 10 frame in different ways using stamps and drawings.

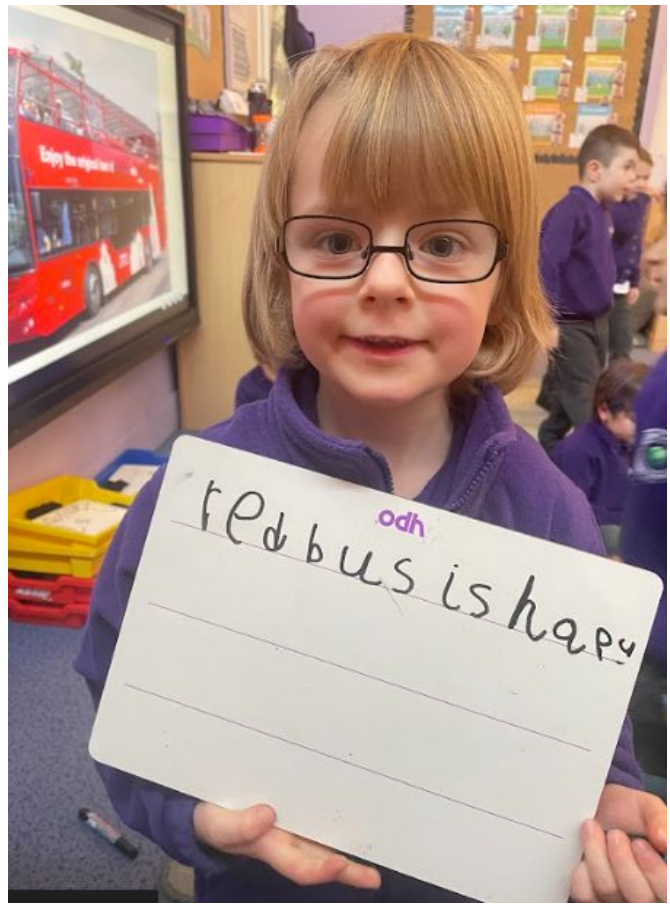

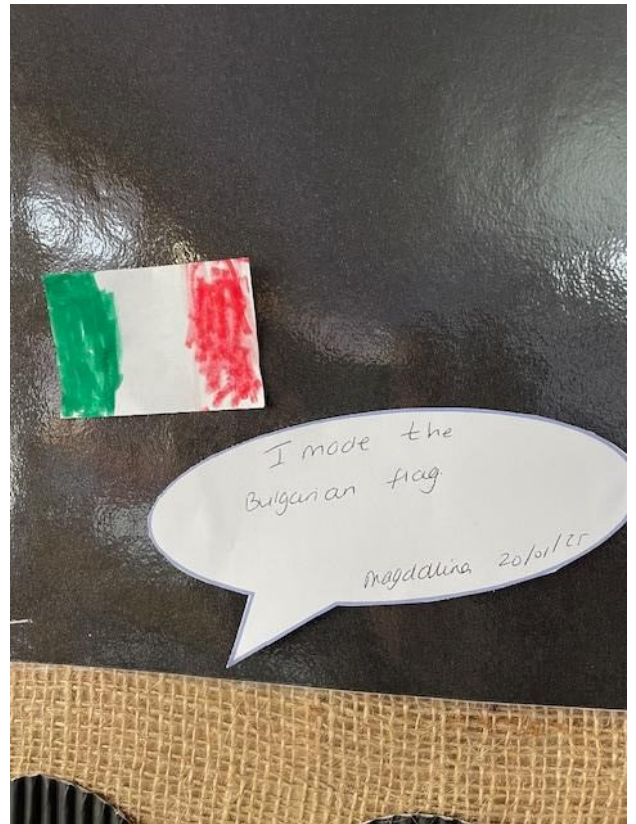
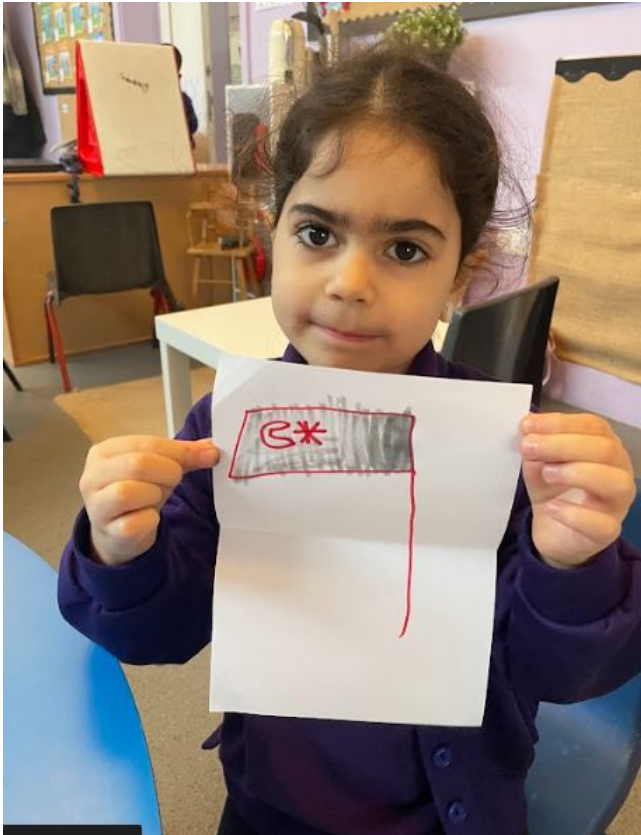
