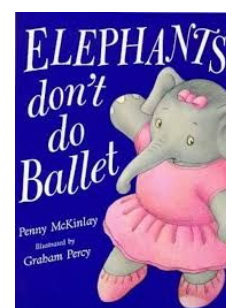
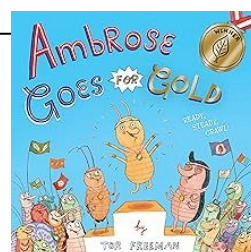
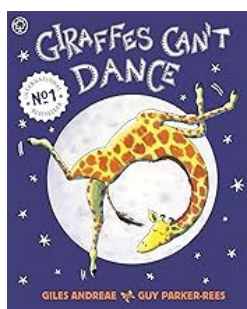
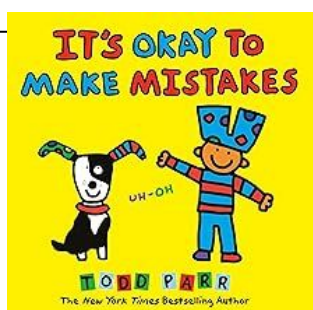
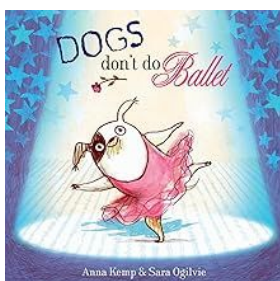
What is your Superpower?

This week we have been learning about why it is important to have a go especially when we are faced with challenges. We read some inspiring stories about characters that have a go at something, even when the path to success is not easy.

The children independently wrote captions to describe their superpowers using their Phonic knowledge.

The children showed off their creativity skills by collaging a picture using a variety of materials.

Last week we learnt what it means to double a number. This week, the children have been practising doubling. We have been learning how to use scales to compare weight. We have been using sentences to say which we think is heavier and which is lighter. We have learnt that if the scales balance then the objects are the same weight.
