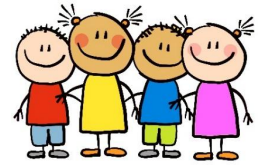
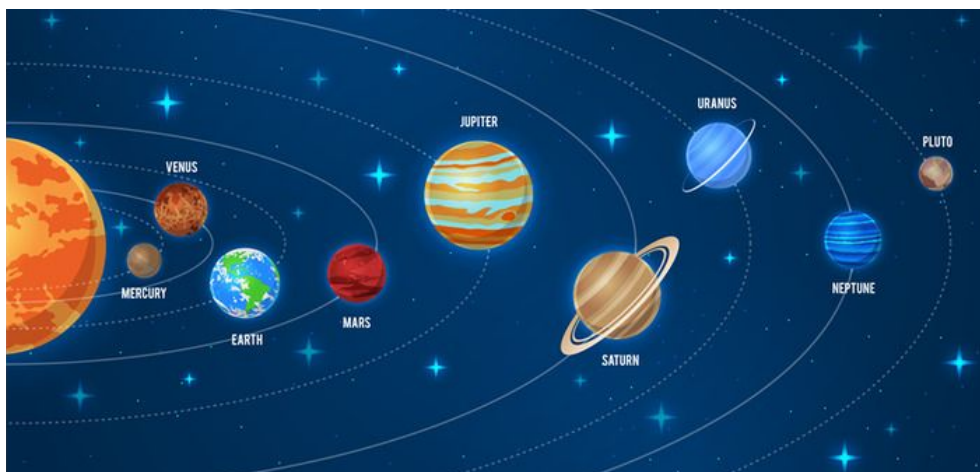


# Peek at the Week



## Our Solar System

In Reception this week, the children have been expanding their knowledge of our Solar system. They have learnt about the properties of the different planets - discussing how many moons each planet has, which planets are gas giants and which are closest to or furthest from the sun. The children have retained a lot of knowledge and have enjoyed writing about the planets using their phonic sounds. The sun came out again, which has meant more fun in the outside garden. The children have had great fun using chalk to draw around themselves and around their shadows and have turned our bikes into gym equipment. In Maths, the children have been learning how to create complex repeating patterns. We are sure they will be able to tell you more about them.

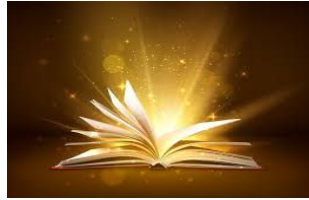
We are very low on

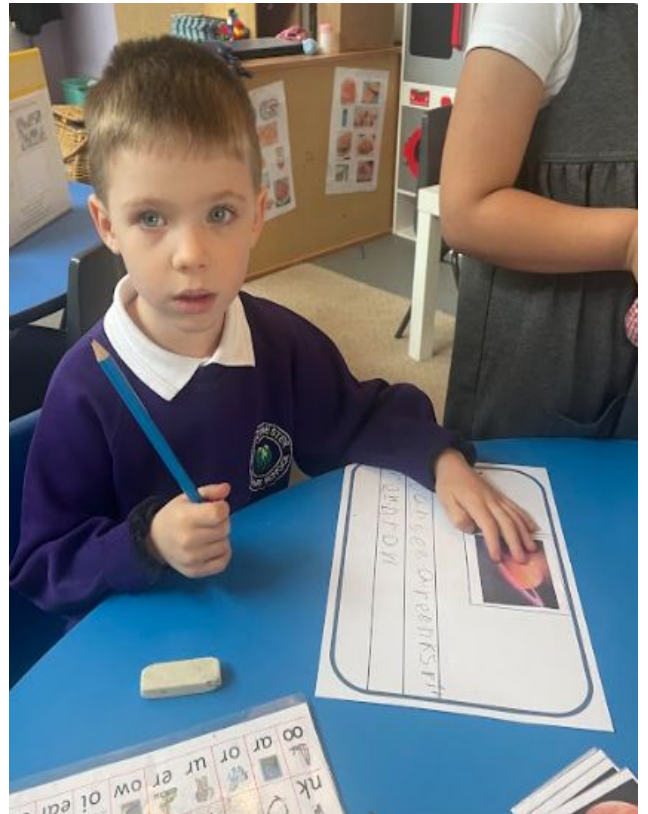

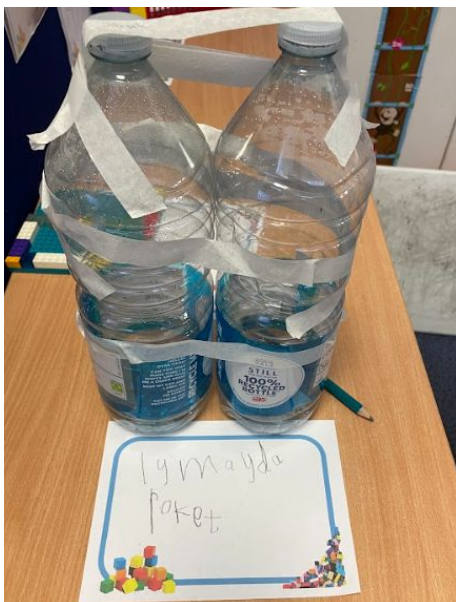

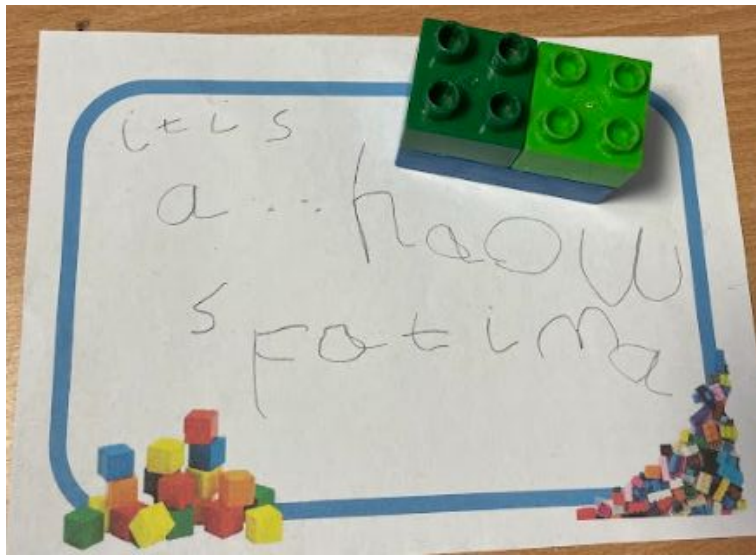
