

Nursery Peek at the Week

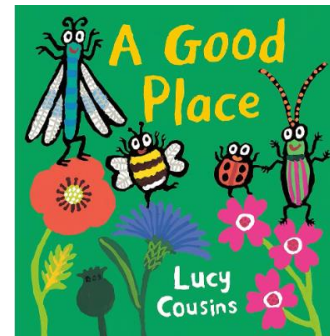
Weekly News

This week in Nursery, we have been learning about insects and what makes a good habitat for different minibeasts to live in. We have learnt that not all minibeasts are insects; to be classified as an insect the animal has to have six legs. We have learnt about different insects and we have enjoyed looking for different minibeasts in the outside area. We have also read the book 'A Good Place' by Lucy Cousins. In this book, four insects are looking for a good place to live. They need flowers for Bee, leaves for Ladybird, a pond for Dragonfly and dead wood for beetle. We have been trying to create areas in our outside area that will make our garden a good place for insects to live. We have learnt that litter and pollution are not good for insects so we have been learning how to recycle things to look after our planet.

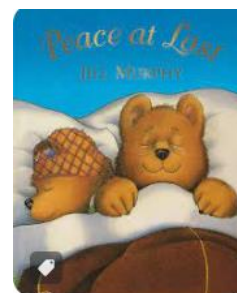
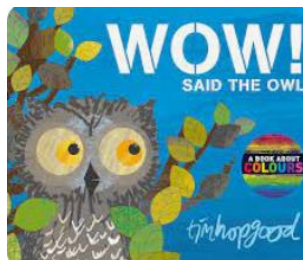

3-a-day Stories for Amber, Casper and Millie group children: The children have learnt our last 3 a day stories really well. These are our new 3 a day stories for next half term:

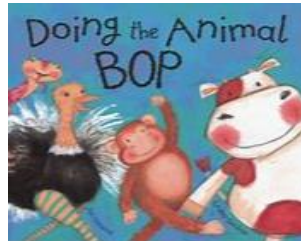
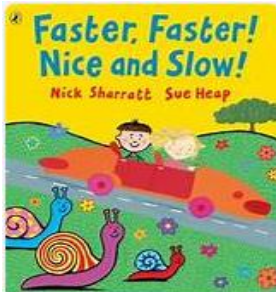


Dip and Do
