Ramadan and Eid

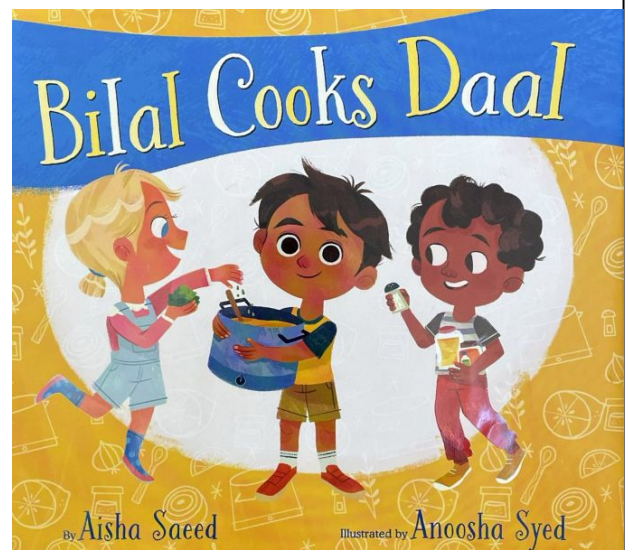
What an amazing week we have had! The children have been learning about the Muslim festival of Ramadan and the special celebration of Eid-ul-Fitr, which happened at the end of the last term! On Wednesday we started to prepare for our own Eid celebration meal. We had dates and daal. The children chopped carrots into very small pieces. They touched the uncooked chana daal, so they could experience what is felt like before it was cooked. We decided not to chop the onion because it might hurt our eyes. We smelt and ground the spices, using a mortar and pestle - coriander, garam masala and cumin. We peeled and smelt garlic cloves and onions, for the dhal. Mrs Rich took all the carrots and other ingredients home and cooked it. It took over 4 hours to cook and we watched a video of what she did. On Thursday afternoon we had a celebration Eid meal in our classes. We started the meal with chopped dates (which is the traditional food eaten at the start of the meal) and then tried some of our home cooked daal.
