We have had a wonderful time enjoying the sunshine this week! We read the fairytale, 'The Three Little Pigs' and the children were introduced to story maps. Story maps are a great visual tool used to help sequence and understand the structure of a story. The children enjoyed drawing pictures and labelling their story maps to help them retell the story. We experimented with different materials to see which little houses couldn't be blown down and why. We have also been using our Phonics to write speech bubble sentences for what the characters in the story might be saying.

In Maths, we have been making teen numbers using ten frames and counters.

The children had their class photos this week and were very sensible on the field. They listened to instructions and gave their best smiley faces!

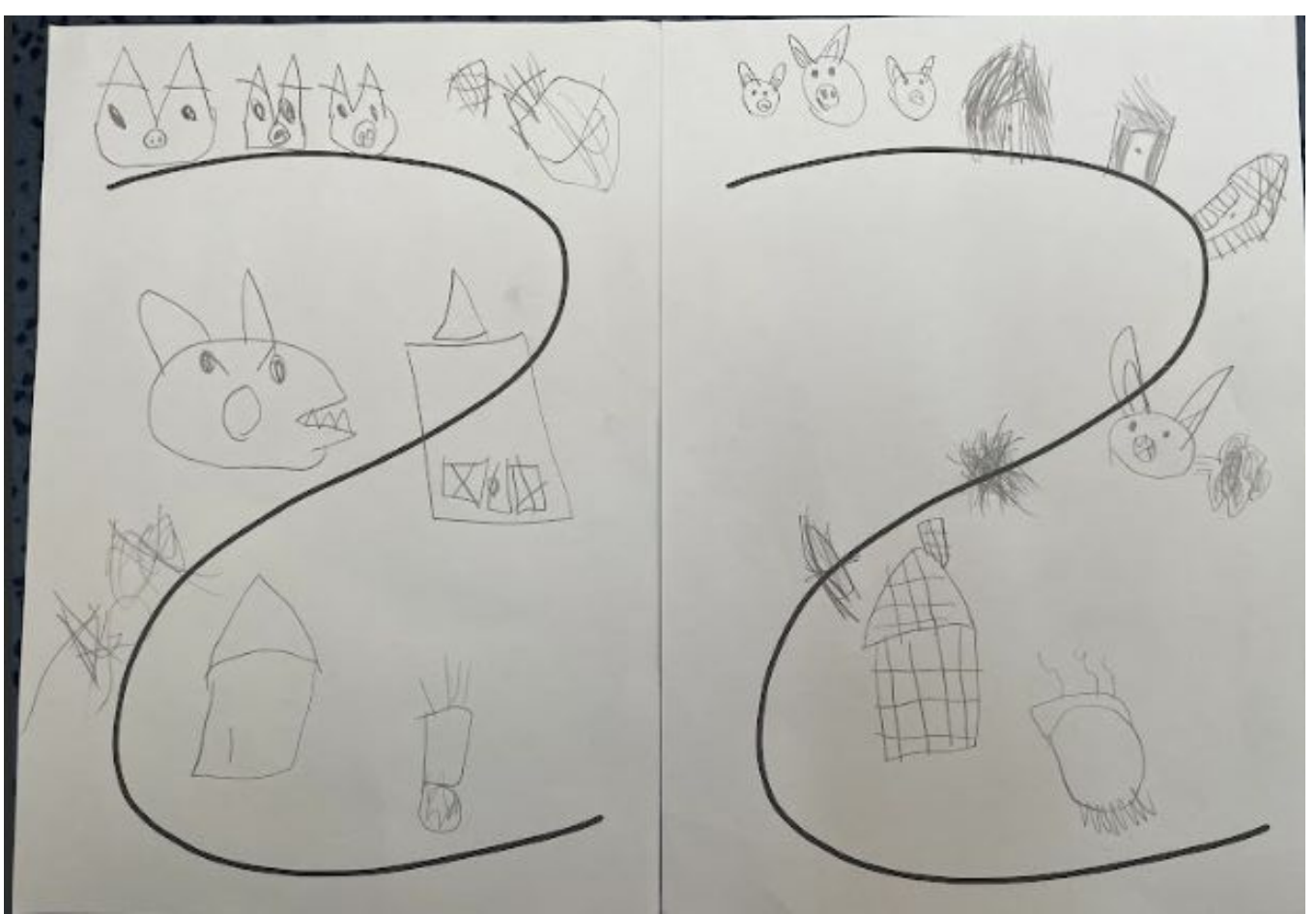
What happens in the beginning, middle and end of The Three Little Pigs? What can you use to help you?



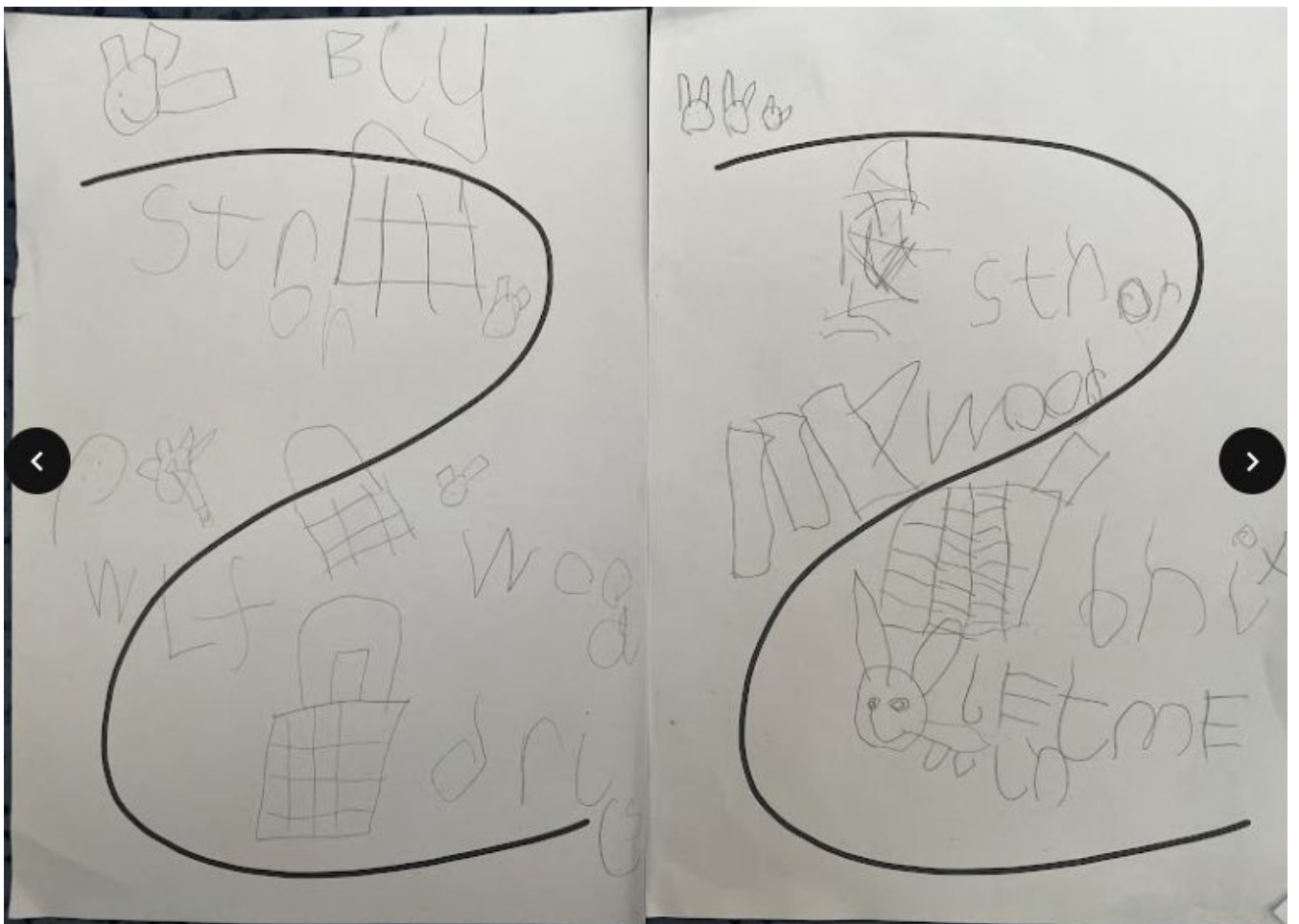




Some of our brilliant story maps!

What sounds can you hear in the shells?



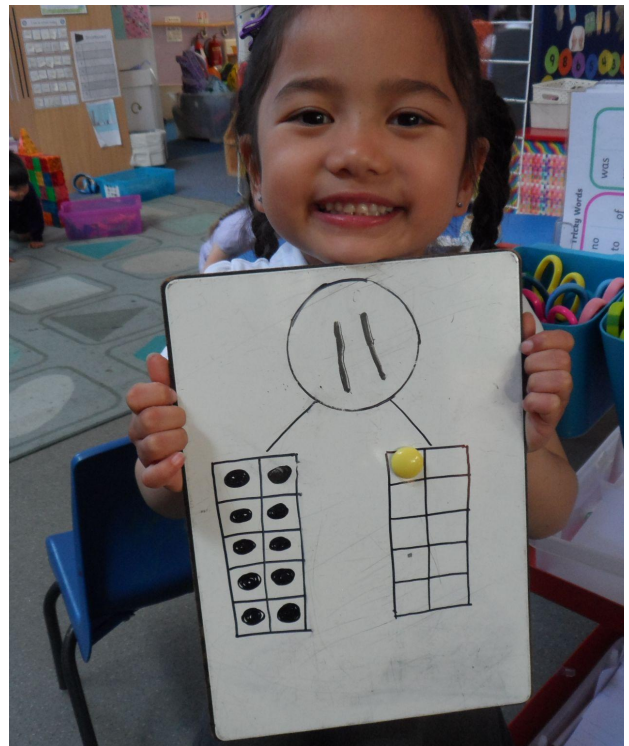
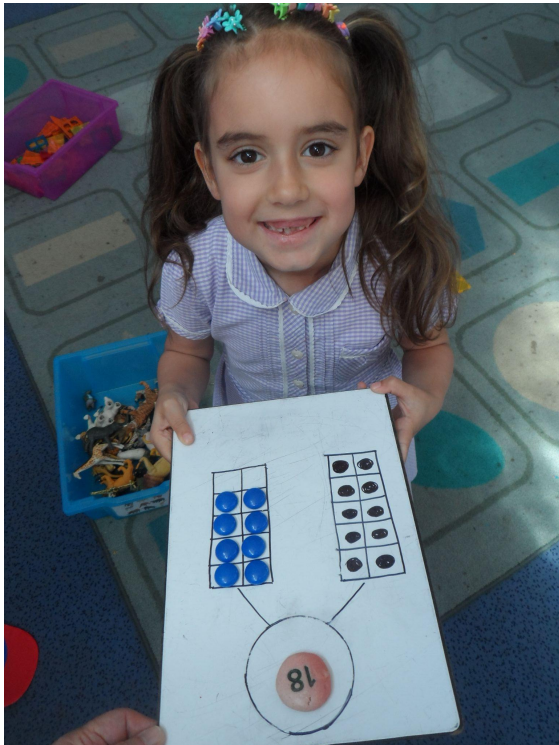
How did you cool yourselves down in the warm weather this week?

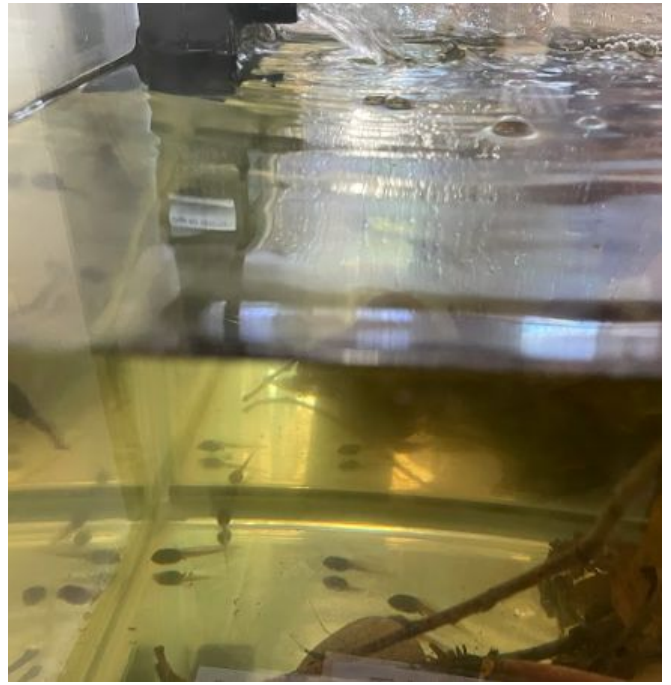


This term the children in Bronze and Silver have been learning to take the afternoon register.

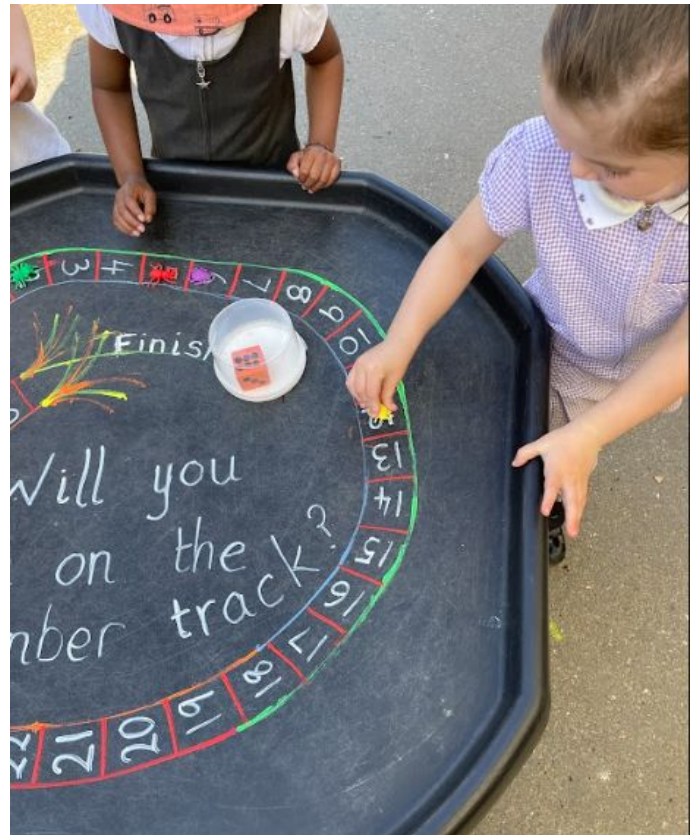


Both classes now have their own tank of tadpoles!
