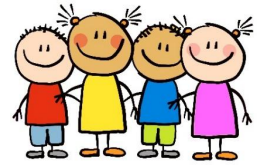


Peek at the Week

Junk Modelling needed!

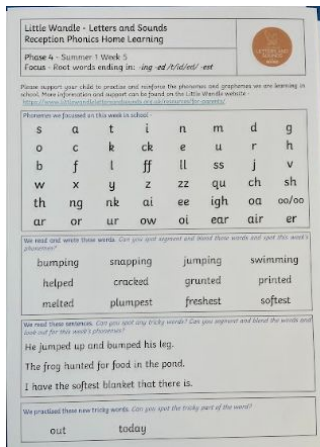

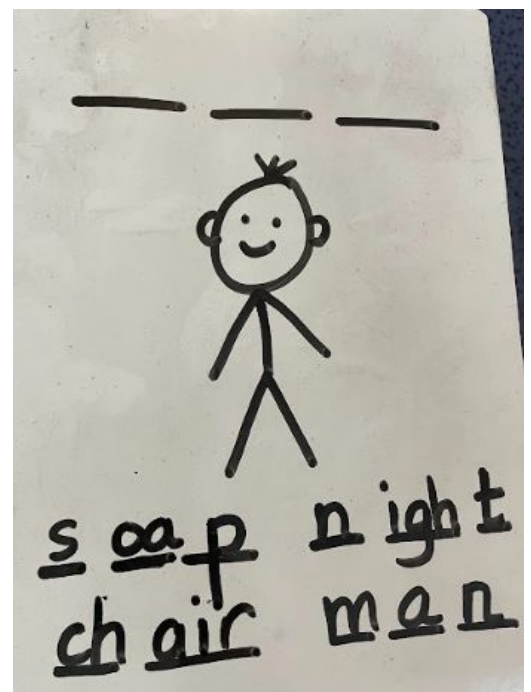
New set of Tricky Words

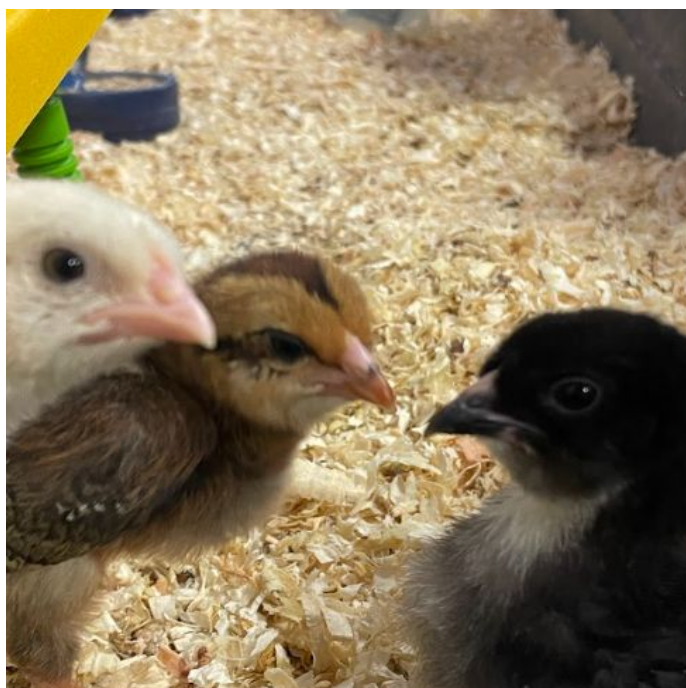

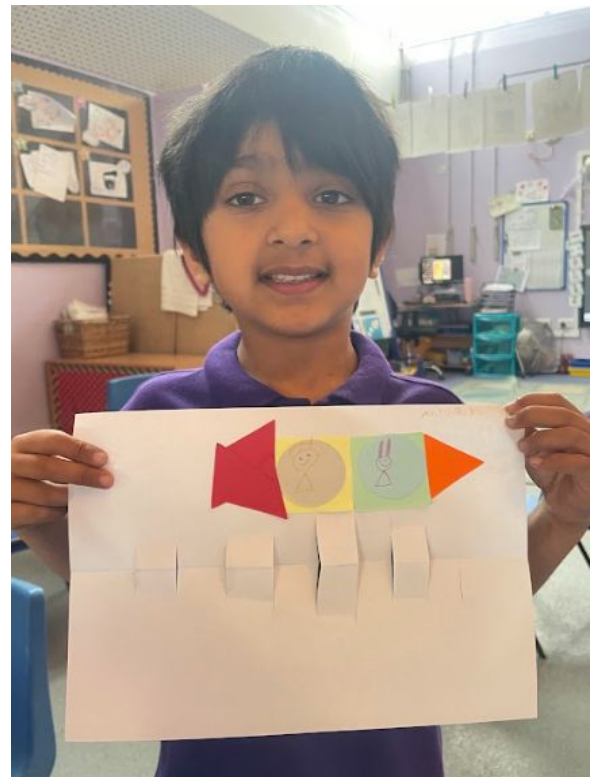

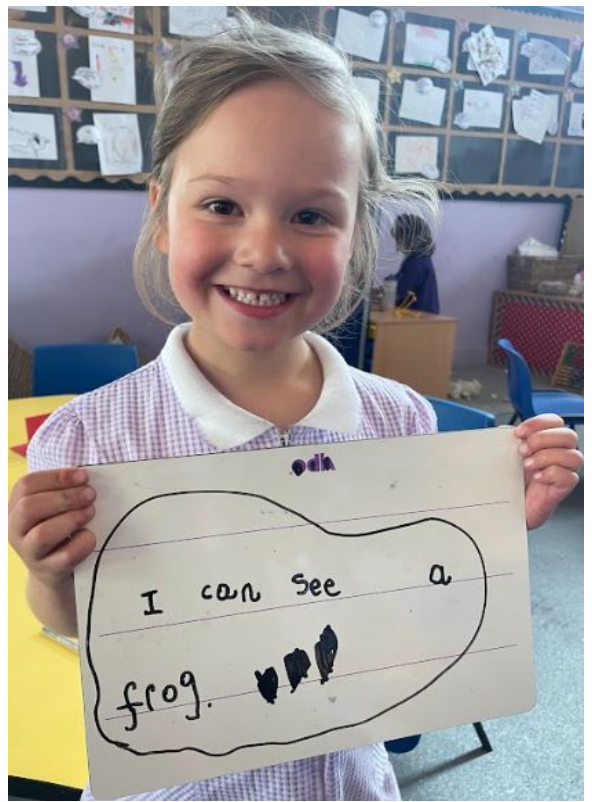
In Maths, we have been revising the properties of 2D shapes and learning how we can create bigger pictures by putting these shapes together.

What picture did you make ?

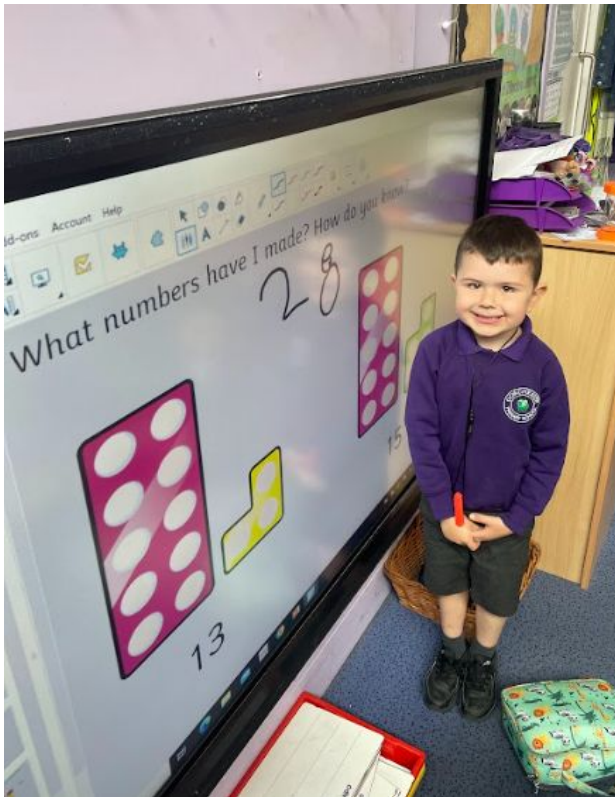




“It’s a house with a path, a wall and windows”
