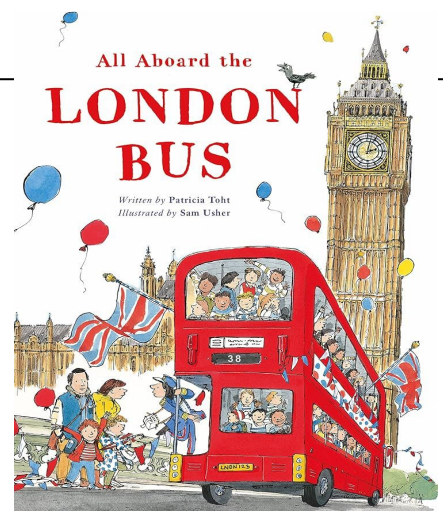


Peek at the Week



All Aboard the London Bus

This week we have read 'All Aboard the London Bus' by Patty Toht. We explored some famous London landmarks including: Big Ben, the London Eye, Buckingham Palace, Tower Bridge and the Tower of London. We looked at the Tower of London in more detail and discovered that it used to have a moat and inside are Ravens, who are looked after by the Beefeaters. We found out that the London Eye has 32 pods and can hold up to 800 people and takes half an hour to go round! We looked at the process of 'changing the guard' and why the King has guards. The children also drew some wonderful maps of London and used construction materials to recreate their favourite landmarks. In Maths, we practised counting beyond 20 and we learned how to add more. We have also been practising for Sports Day next week!

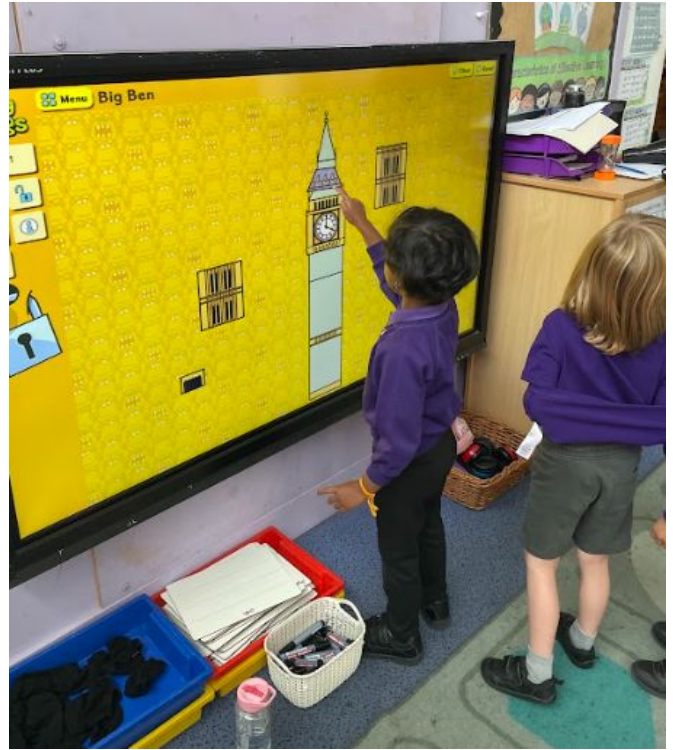


What facts about London have you learnt this week?

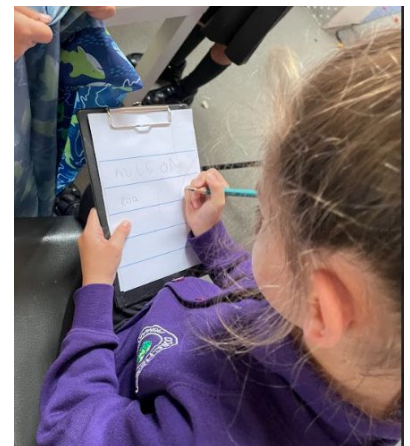


Which London landmark did you build/create? Which one is your favourite and why?

Last week the webbing was used as a rugby post. This week it was moved down the post and became a hurdle. Great jumping everyone!

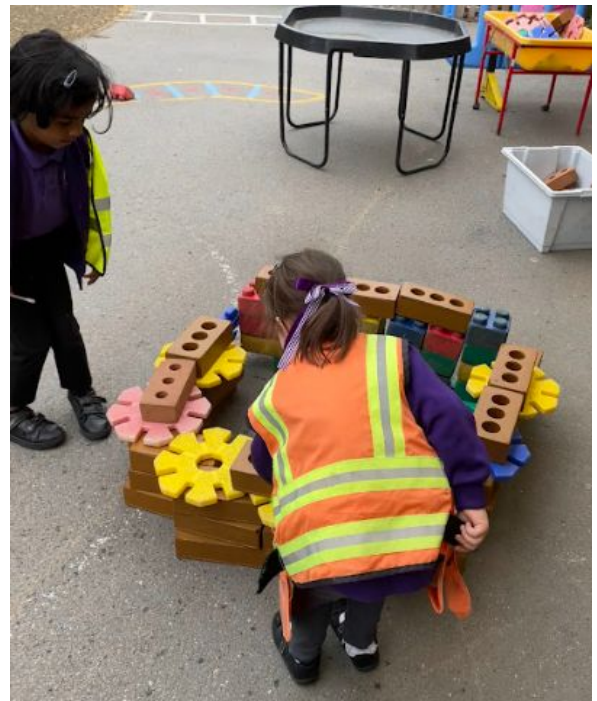


Exercise and sport is in the air as we get closer to Sports Day!

Three children reading three-a-day books!

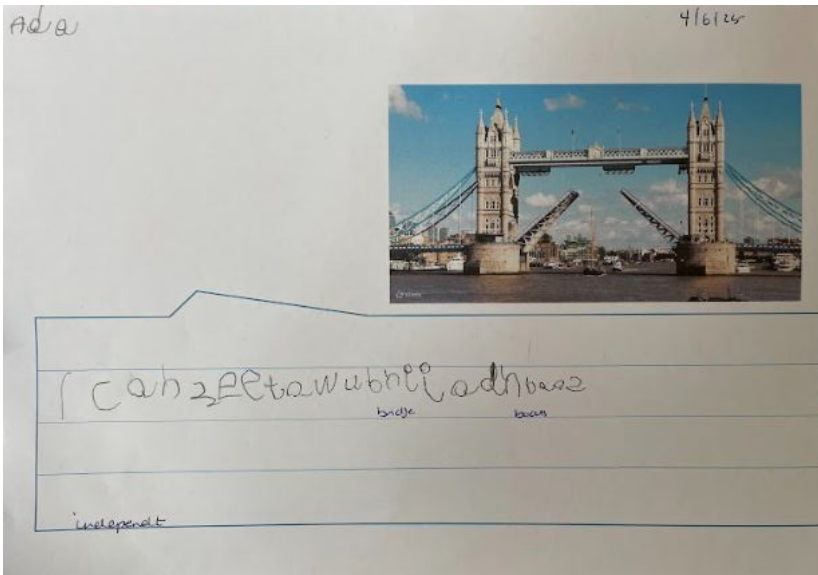




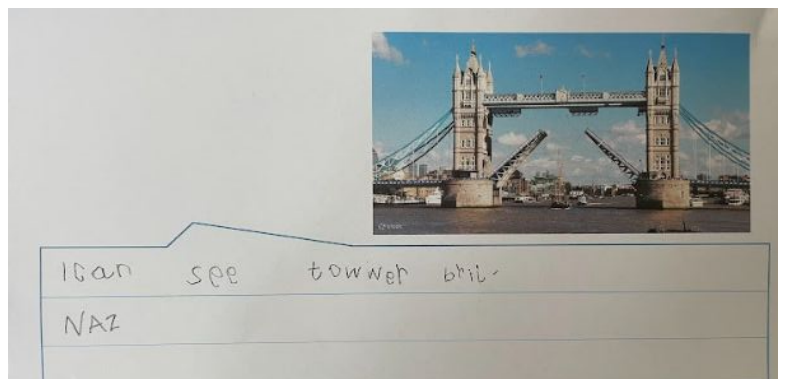
A great example of spontaneous cooperation. The tuff spot needed to go back on the table Team work!

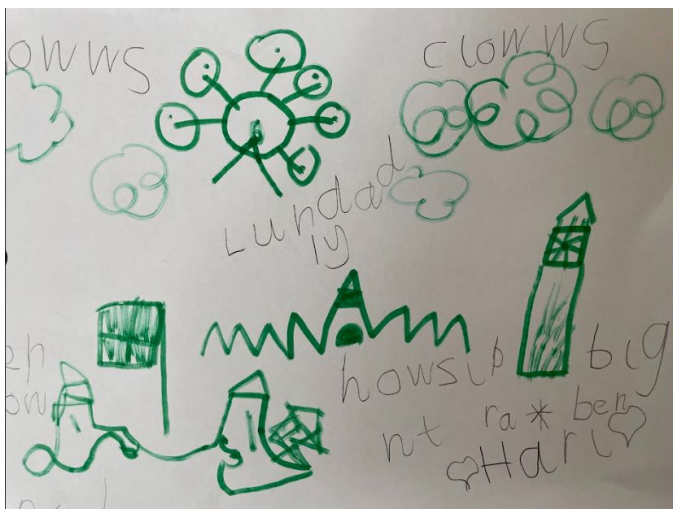


What do blue and yellow make?
