## Enquiry Question of the week

Each week we will post an Enquiry Question from the week's learning alongside the answer we would expect. Ask your child the question and see how close your child is to answering the question fully. If they are finding it tricky, break down the answer together and see if they can work on learning more at home.

**What are the four noble truths?**

The Four Noble Truths are the core teachings of Buddhism, outlining the nature of suffering, its cause, the possibility of ending suffering, and the path to achieving that end. They are: the truth of suffering (dukkha), the truth of the origin of suffering (samudaya), the truth of the cessation of suffering (nirodha), and the truth of the path to the cessation of suffering (maggā).
