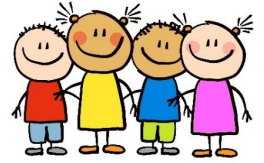


# Peek at the Week

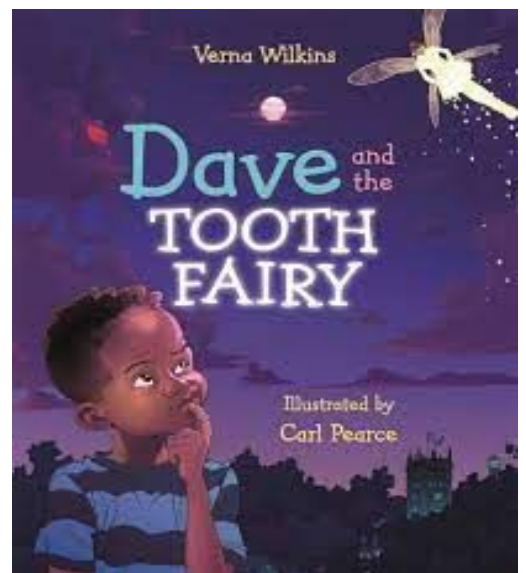


## Dave and the Tooth Fairy

We discussed why we have teeth and what we use them for. The children shared stories about how they clean their teeth and how often. We also talked about the healthy foods that we need to eat and which foods help to keep our teeth strong and healthy.

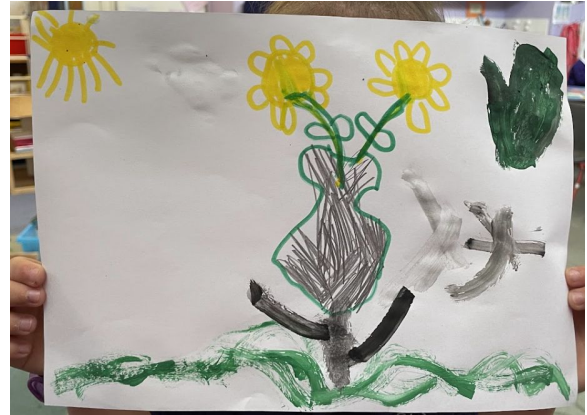

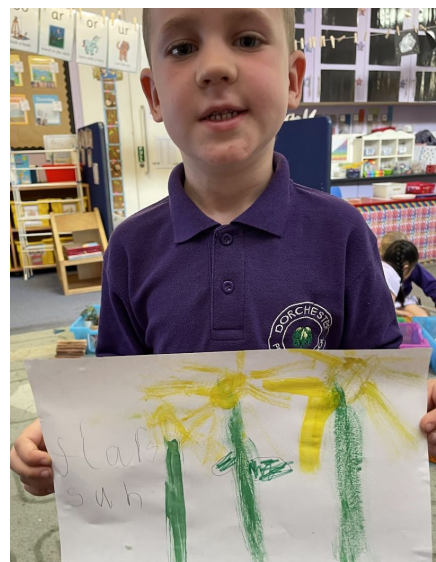


Retelling the story of The Very Hungry Caterpillar

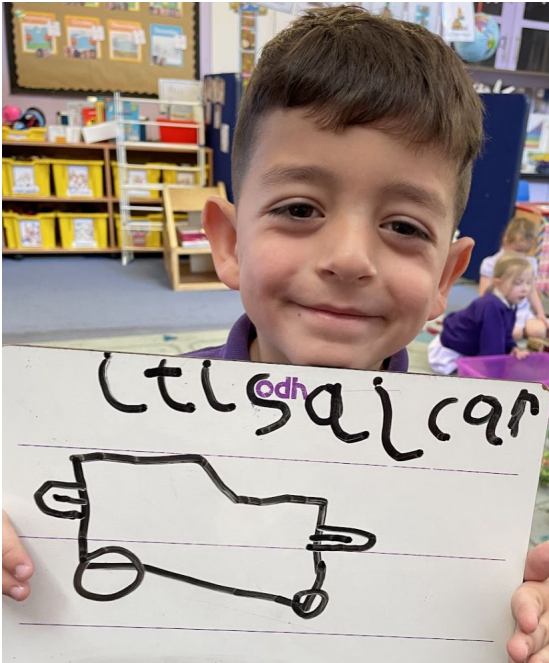

So much time and precision went into creating this paradise.

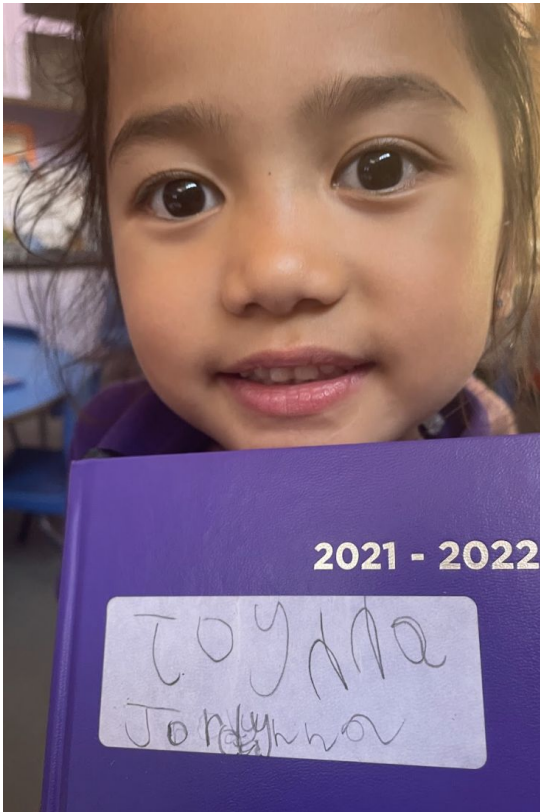


Bronze Class had a story told to them in Greek this week! They listened so well. Do your family speak another language at home?

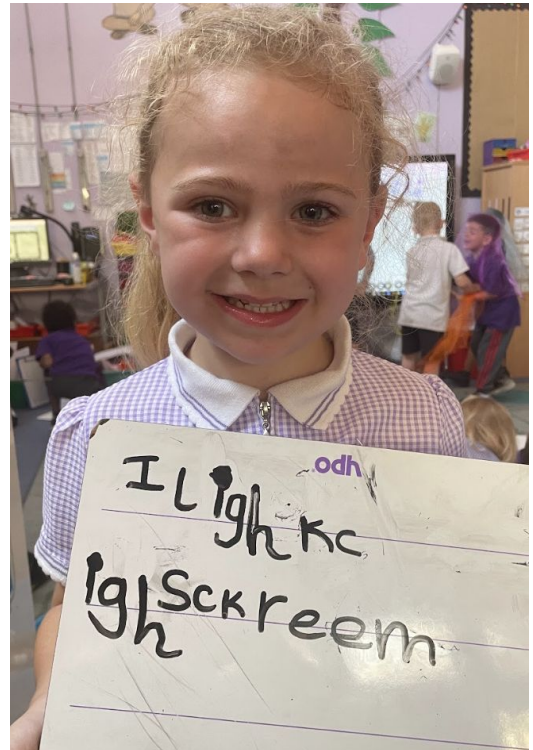


It is important to use knives carefully when preparing food. Do you help to prepare food at home?

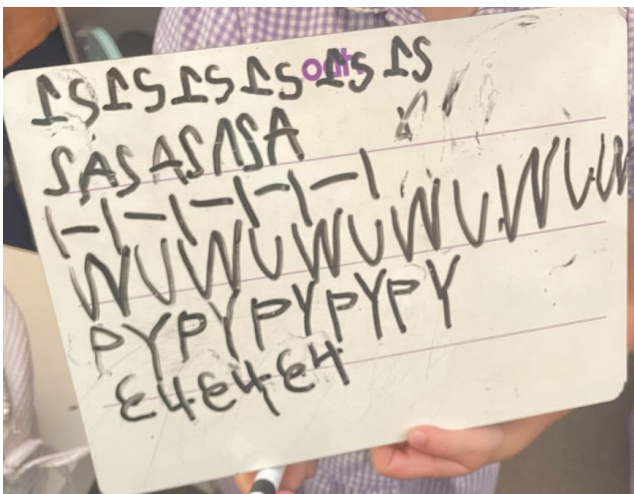
