

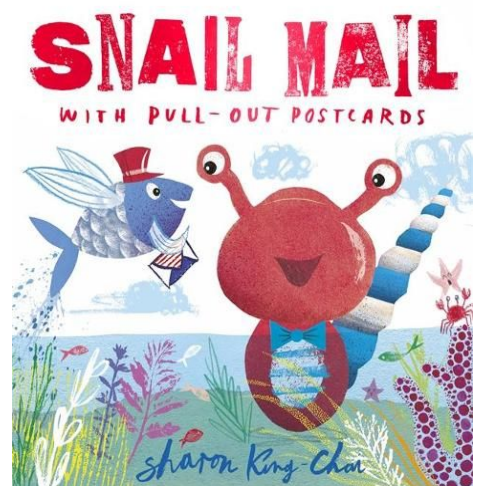
Peek at the Week

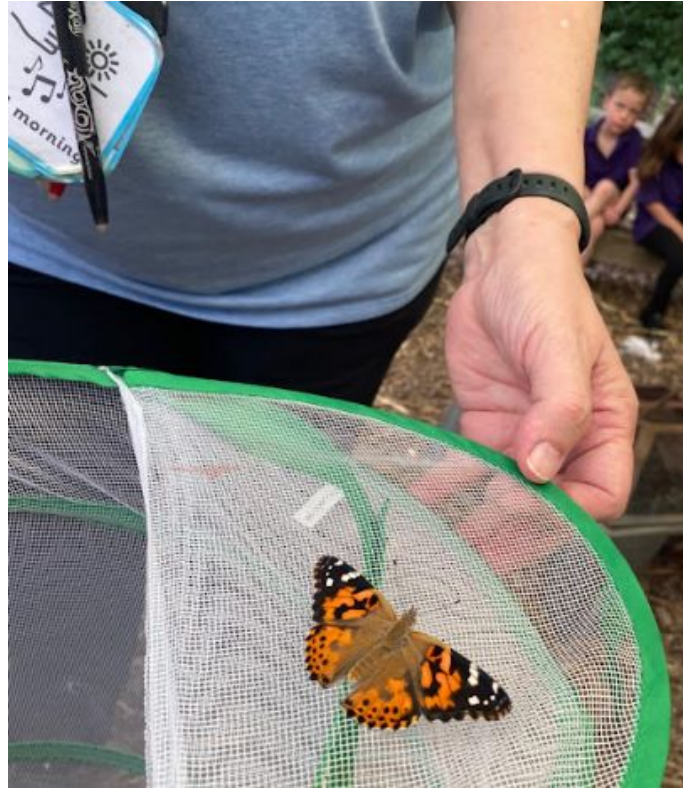

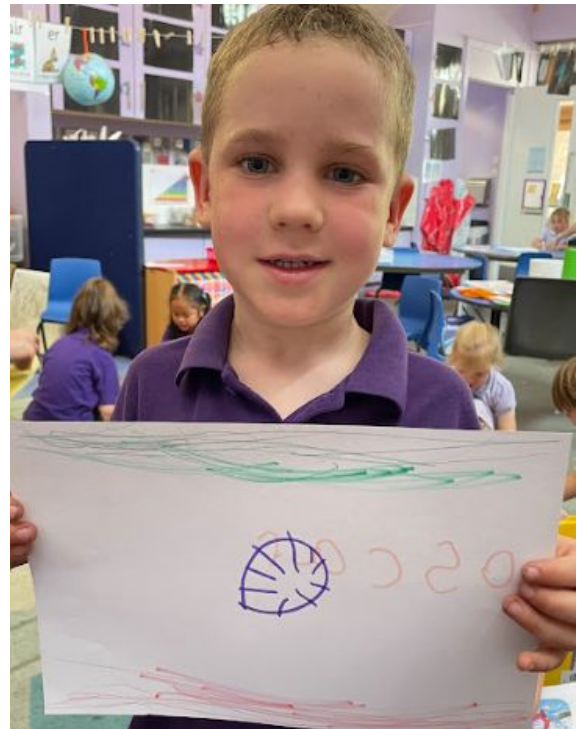

The children wanted to sweep and tidy the playground this week. They used brooms and shovels to put the bark back into the mud kitchen area.

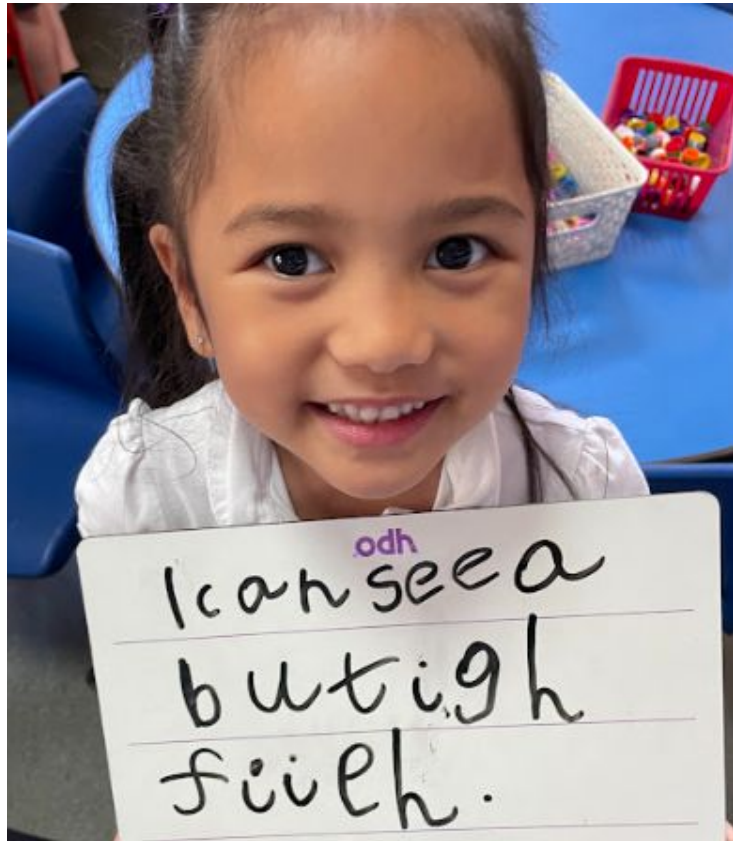
