Enquiry Question of the week

Each week we will post an Enquiry Question from the week's learning alongside the answer we would expect. Ask your child the question and see how close your child is to answering the question fully. If they are finding it tricky, break down the answer together and see if they can work on learning more at home.

EQ: What are the main festivals celebrated by Buddhists?

Buddhists celebrate various festivals in different ways depending on the type of Buddhism they follow. Some of the main festivals celebrated by Buddhists include:

Wesak: Celebrated in May, Wesak commemorates the birth, enlightenment, and death of the Buddha. Buddhists engage in acts of generosity, meditation, and reflection on this day.

Katina day: Celebrated in October, Katina day marks the end of the Buddhist Lent period, during which monks traditionally stay in one place for meditation and study. Laypeople offer robes and other necessities to monks as part of the Katina ceremony.
