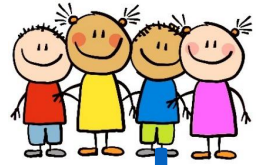


Peek at the Week

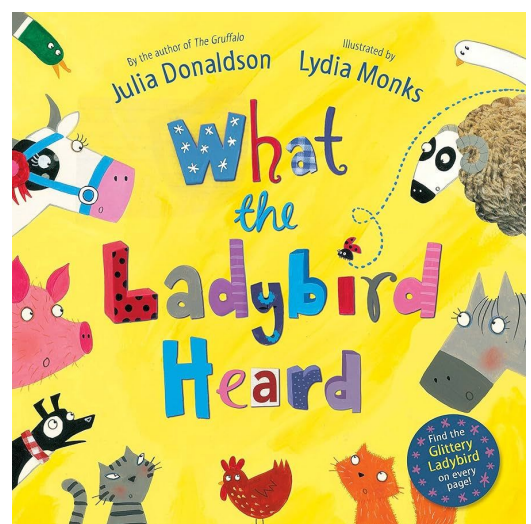

A few reminders...

The children will need to wear their white school polo top with joggers/shorts or their school dresses (weather dependent) for the trip. The children need to wear suitable shoes, such as trainers.

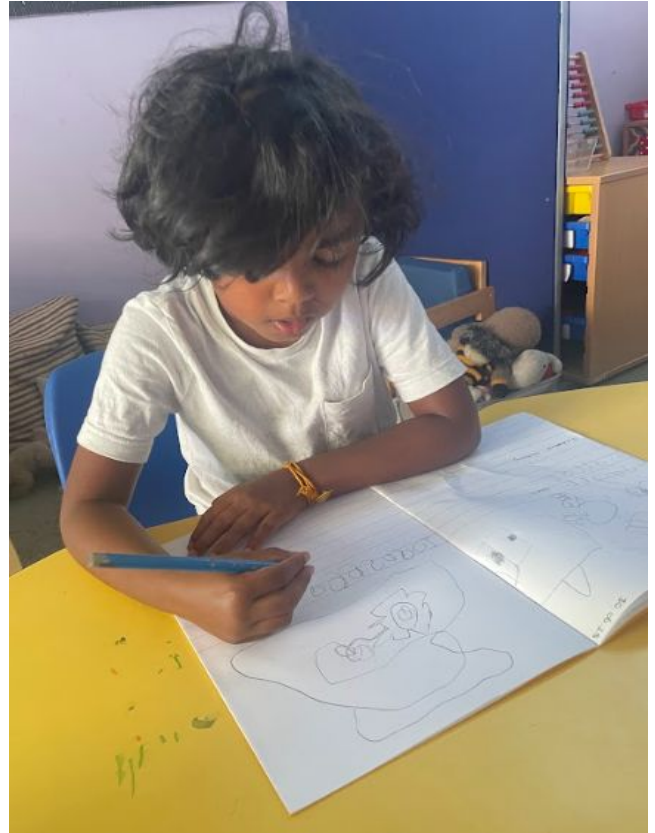
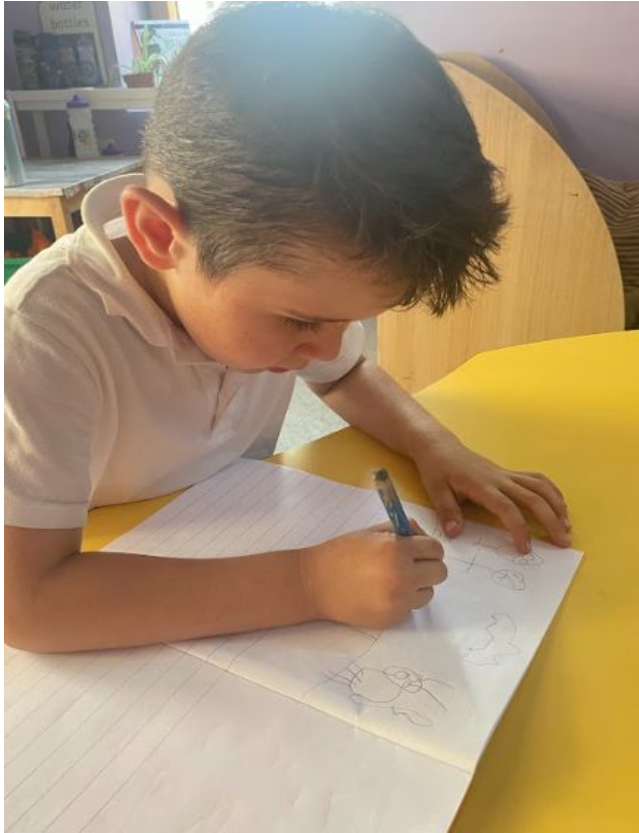

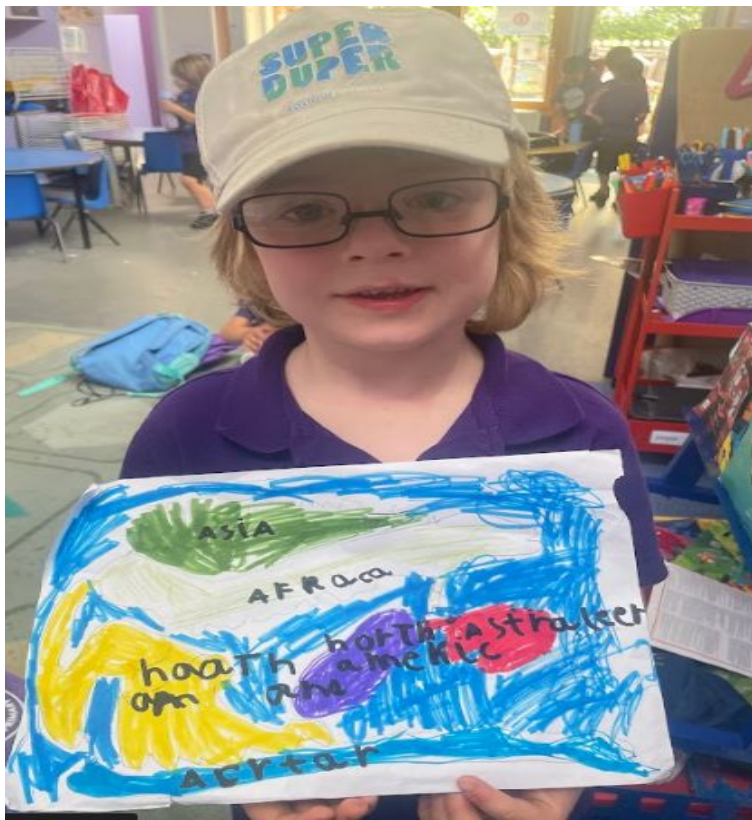

If you press the pan, then the barrier goes up and you can drive through.



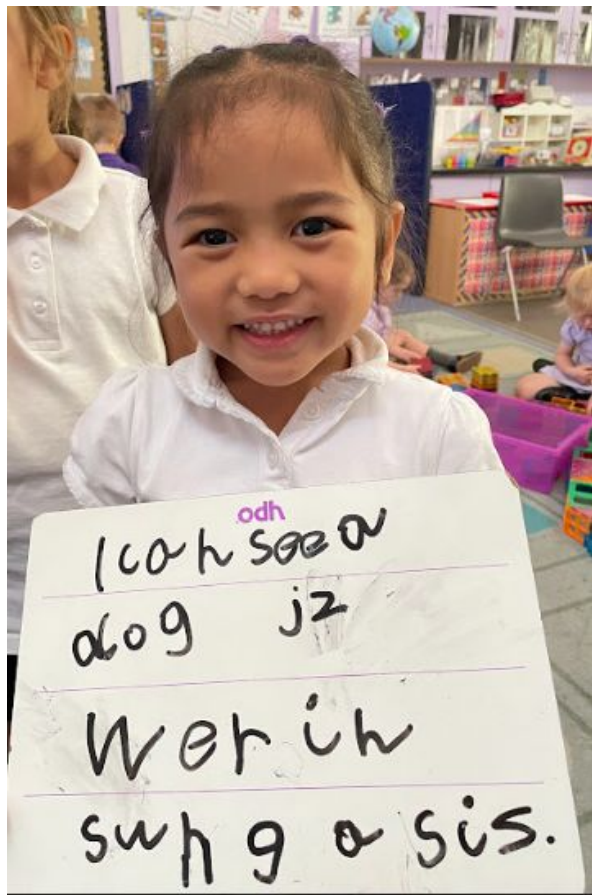
Can you flip the playdough pancake and catch it?
