Enquiry Question of the week

Who were the Vikings and what do we know about them?

A: The term Viking refers to people who moved to other countries from Scandinavian countries - Denmark, Sweden and Norway. The Vikings used longboats to cross The North Sea and invade Britain - often violently- and other European countries. Vikings wore armor and used shields to protect themselves; they used weapons such as long swords and axes. Some Vikings were not warriors and arrived peacefully to settle. They were farmers and grew crops.

In Science this week, we learnt about different materials. Find 5 objects in your home which have different properties and record them in a table like we did in class.

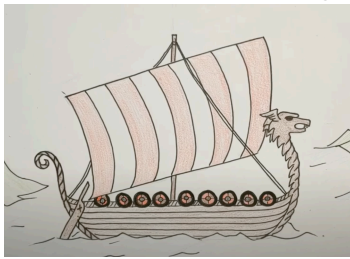
Please see the example below:
