Things to know for next week:

Enquiry Question of the week

Can you describe where countries in the UK are using the directions north, south, east and west?

A: Examples include: England is south of Scotland. Wales is west of England. To add to this, some children were challenged to describe diagonal positions, such as Scotland is north east of Wales. England is south east of Northern Ireland.

A summary of next week:

Phonics: review phase 5 sounds.

Reading: Retrieval skills using The Magic Finger text.

Writing: Text: The Jolly Postman. Skills: understand how to write letters.

Maths: Estimating and comparing numbers up to 100.

Geography: What are the common map symbols and why are they used?

Science: How are different materials suitable for different purposes?

RE: What can we learn from the stories of Jesus?

PSHE: Who is in our family, and how our families can all be different from each other.

Art: Creative journeys and Christmas cards.
