- ★ Amber Class trip to Pizza Express - Wednesday 24th September

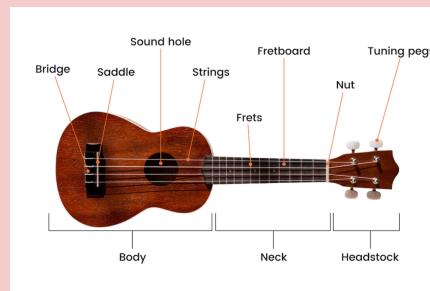
Enquiry Question of the week

Roll a dice three times and write what number was rolled and create a 3 digit number. Repeat and create another 3 digit number. Can you compare them using $>$ and $<$. Repeat this for 5 sets of numbers. Challenge: can you explain how you know which is the greater/smaller number?
