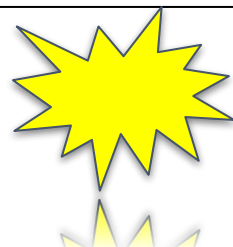
What can we do to help ourselves?

Harvest Assembly

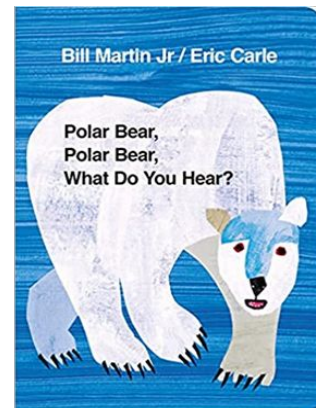
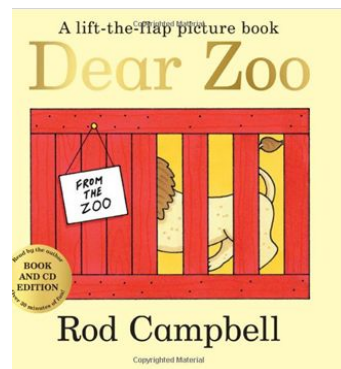
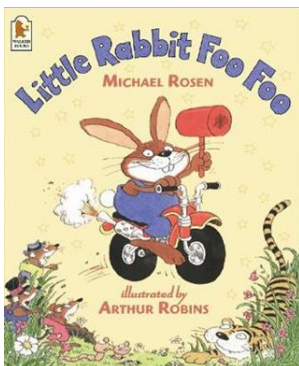
Thank you to all the parents who came to Harvest Assembly and to those who donated food. The children performed so confidently. We were very proud of them.

Did you get a turn on the hopscotch?



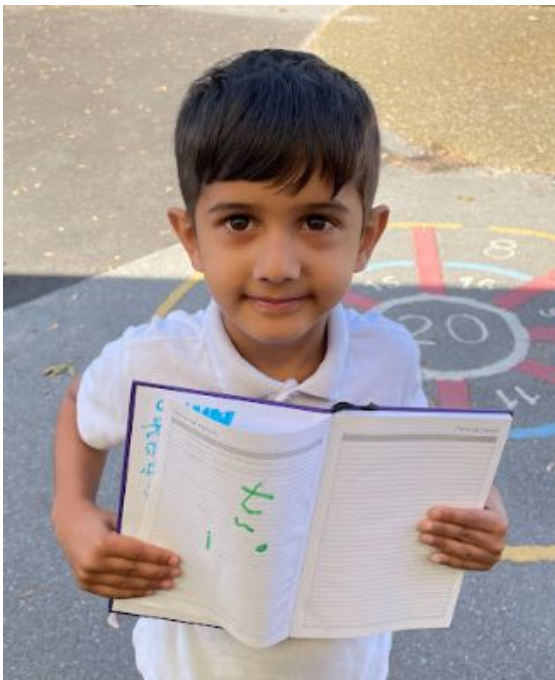
We love team work!

They look proud of their effort to work together on the puzzle.



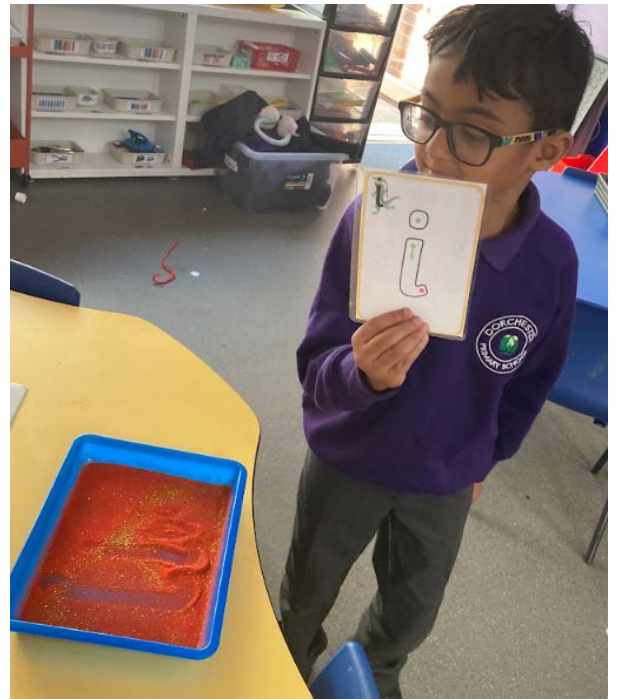
Good shot! What sport are they playing?
