Enquiry Question of the week

Were the Vikings settlers or invaders?

A: The Vikings conquered Britain in an initially violent manner. They invaded Lindisfarne and killed many innocent monks and they continued to invade parts of Britain in this same manner. Axes, spears, and swords all support this theory as well as the GRAVE MARKER: 'THE DOMESDAY STONE' found at Lindisfarne.
