Enquiry Question of the week

Please take some time to ask your child the question and see how close your child is to answering the question fully. If they are finding it tricky, break down the answer together and see if they can continue to work on their learning at home.

What landmarks, human and physical features can you identify from aerial photos of London?

A: London is made up of different areas. There are physical features - such as some large parks like Hyde Park. There is a river called The Thames, which runs through London. There are many famous human features, such as famous landmarks like The Gherkin, The London eye, Buckingham Palace and The Shard. We can see these features in aerial photos by looking for colours and shapes (green grass and trees or grey/ silver rectangular buildings).

A summary of next week:

Phonics: review phase 5 sounds.

Writing: Preparing for our first Star Write! Retelling the story of The Jolly Postman.

Maths: Addition skills - using number lines to add up to ten and then past ten. Adding 3 1-digit numbers.

Computing: Analysing information and composing emails.

Geography: How would we use common map symbols to show the features of Worcester Park on a map? (after our walk).

Art: Take one picture (National Gallery competition)

Science: Natural and Man-made materials

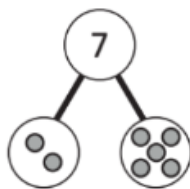

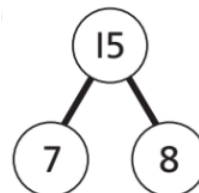
