

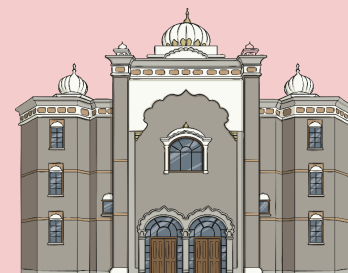
# Peek into next week Year 3

## Autumn Term Week 5



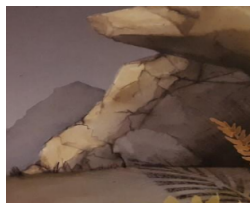
### You must:
