### **What is significant about Hindu prayer and worship?**

Hindu prayer and worship (called puja) are important ways that Hindus show love and respect to God. Hindus believe in one main God, Brahman, but God is shown in many different forms, like Vishnu, Shiva, Lakshmi, and others. At home many Hindus have a small shrine with pictures or statues of gods. At the temple (mandir) people come together to pray, sing, and offer food or flowers.

#### You must:

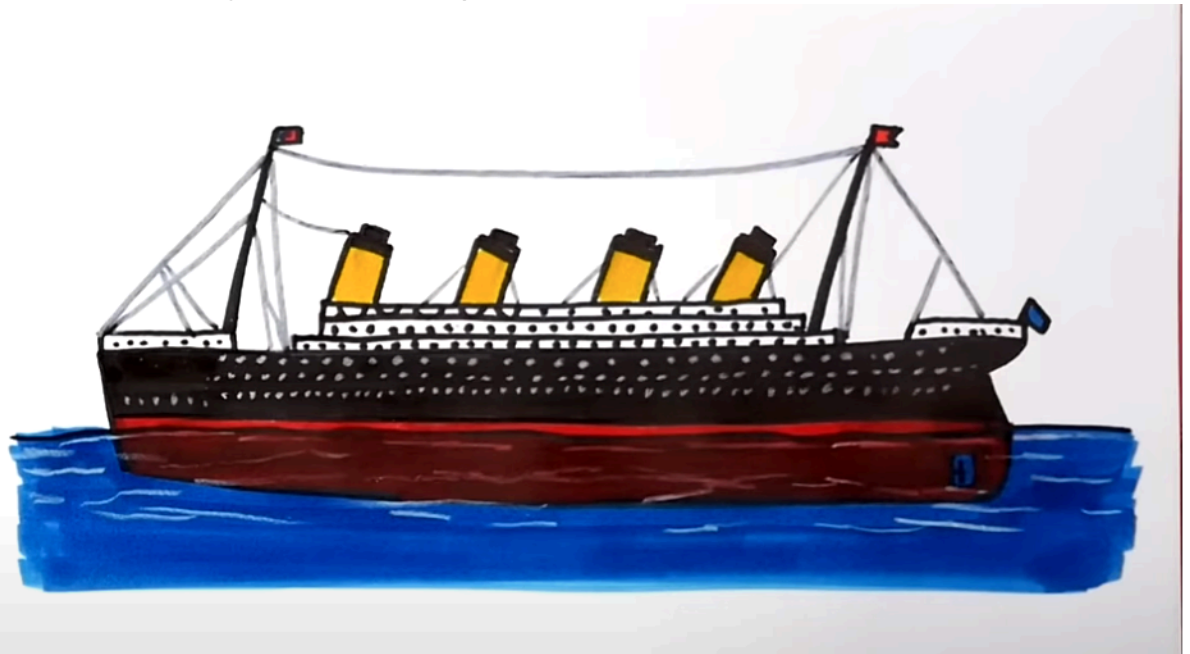
- Read daily at home for at least 20 minutes and record this in your diary. Diaries are checked on a Friday/Monday but you must have your reading folder in everyday.

The Titanic was a luxury ocean liner built in Belfast, Northern Ireland in 1912. A company called White Star Line asked the shipbuilders Harland and Wolff to construct the ship. It took three years to complete and was ready to take passengers on the ocean by the 31<sup>st</sup> March 1912.
