Enquiry Question of the week

What are the careers we can have in medicine and how have they changed over time?

This week in History we discussed how medicine has changed over time. For example - technology over time has improved, so instead of one doctor for everything, we now have specialists, like orthopaedic doctors, paediatricians for babies/ children and dentists for teeth. Nurses, who take care of us when we're in the hospital, now do many important things and make sure we feel better. There are also scientists who discover new ways to help us, like finding cures for illnesses.

Please could you make some time this weekend to sit together and read a book, preferably an unfamiliar one, and ask them lots of questions about what they are reading.

Questions you can ask your child about their book.

- ★ Who is the main character?
- ★ Where is the story set?
- ★ What was the problem in the story and how was it solved?
- ★ What do you think will happen next in your story?
- ★ Which character do you like most? Why?
- ★ Which character do you think would make a good friend? Why?
- ★ What was your favourite part of the story?
- ★ Did you like the ending? Why/why not?
