

Peek into next week Year 4

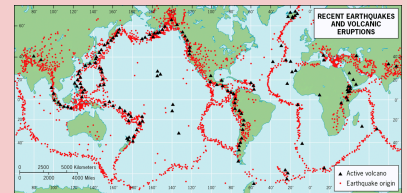
Things to know:
